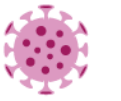
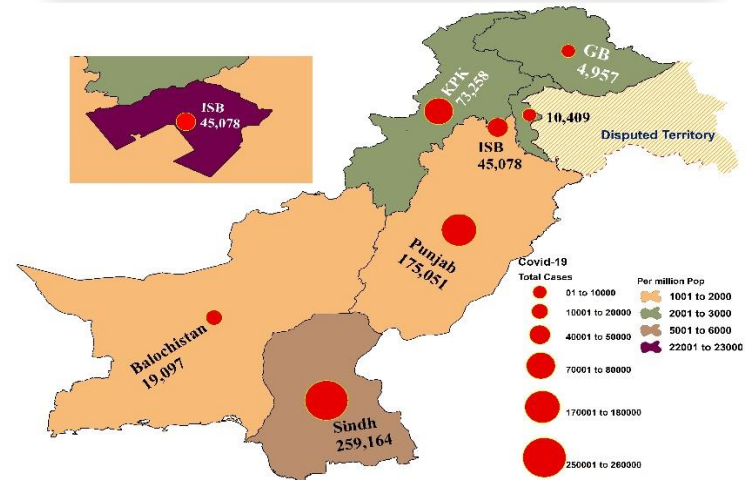

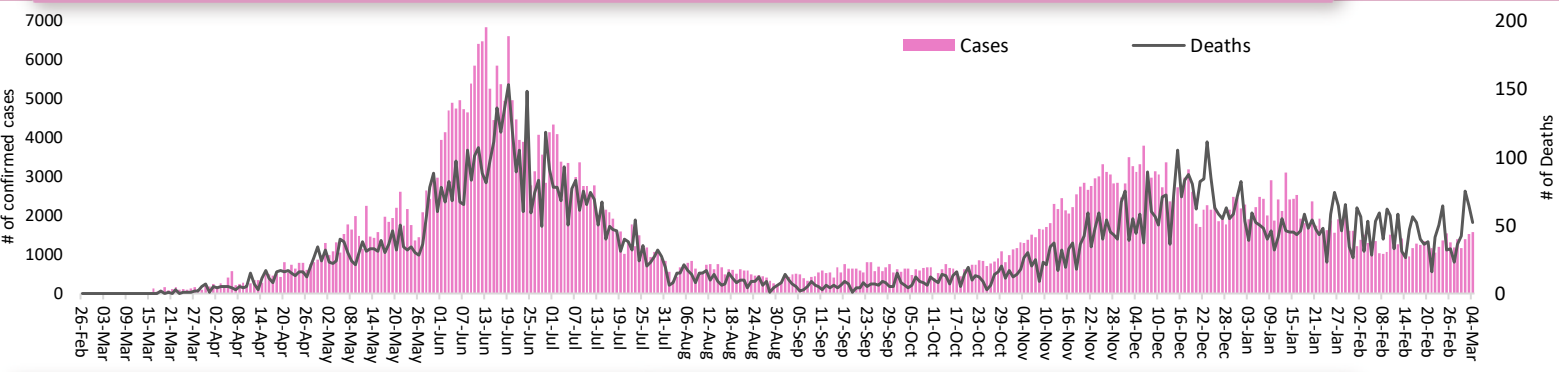

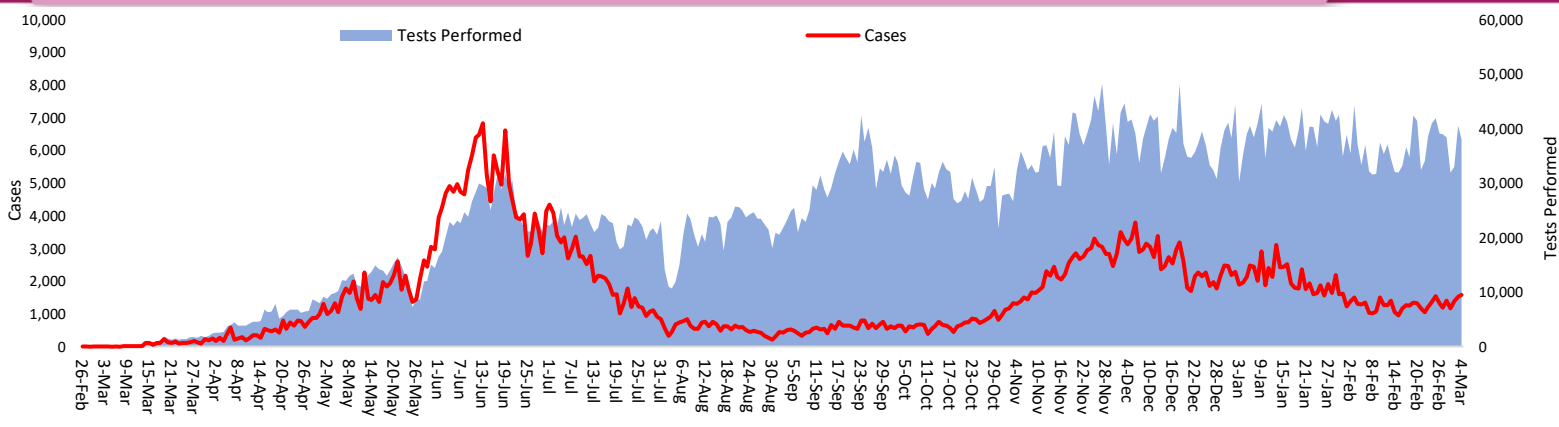

MEETING AND COORDINATION

On 4th March 2021, WHO Country Representative, Pakistan Dr Palitha Mahipala met with the Resident Representative United Nations Development Program (UNDP), Mr Knut Ostby at WHO country office Pakistan.

WR briefed Mr Knut on the declining trend of the daily COVID-19 cases, the current government response in surveillance, laboratory testing, community mobilization, maintenance of essential health services and SARS-CoV-2 vaccination in Pakistan. Dr Palitha highlighted that WHO is providing technical and financial support to the Government of Pakistan for the COVID-19 Pandemic response. He appreciated the Government of Pakistan's efforts to control the COVID-19 outbreak in the country. Dr Palitha and Mr Knut agreed to continue the support to Government of Pakistan for COVID-19 response.
