

# PAKISTAN CIVID-19 SITUATION REPORT





### **Meeting and Coordination**





The Provincial Department of Health, AJK in collaboration with the World Health Organization Pakistan conducted a baseline survey of patient safety at the District Headquarter Hospital Kotli-AJK from 29th to 30th June 2021. The purpose of the survey was to check on the compliance with the identified 25 key areas of patient safety standards by the different hospital departments, with a view of improving the quality of health services in the hospital.

The Survey was conducted by WHO patient safety focal person Ms. Afifa Baloch, National Patient Safety Expert, Dr Rubina Aman, and patient safety advisory Dr Hussain Jafri. Recommendations were presented to the District Health Officer, Kotli, Dr Syed Shafqat and Medical Superintendent DHQ Kotli Dr Nasrullah.

The District Health officer appreciated WHO for this effort, that will go a long way in improving patient safety in the quest for quality health services.
