

### Executive Summary


Pakistan reported **644** new cases of COVID-19 on **04 October 2020**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **315,260** with **6,517** deaths (**CFR: 2.07%**). Out of the total **8,914** currently active cases, **761** cases are hospitalized, out of which **508 (66.75%)** are in critical condition. **8,153** COVID-19 positive cases are at designated isolation facilities or in-home isolation. A total of **299,836 (95.11%)** have recovered and discharged.

### Daily Incidence by Province




### Daily Incidence/Mortality

10-Jun - 04 Oct 2020




### Daily Lab Test conducted

10-Jun to 04-Oct 2020




### Daily COVID-19 Positivity Rate

WHO Pakistan in collaboration with Provincial Health Department Punjab, conducted a one-day training of District trainers on microplanning for Typhoid Conjugate Vaccine (TCV) Catch-up Campaign 2021. The training was conducted at Hotel One Multan on 2<sup>nd</sup> October 2020.


The objective of the training was to build capacity of the District Health Officers, District Vaccination Supervisors and EPI focal persons from district Lodhran, Khanewal, Pakpattan, Sahiwal, Okara, Rahim Yar Khan, Bahawalpur, Bahawalnagar, DG Khan Rajanpur and Muzaffargarh on TCV microplanning for the catch-up campaign. Training methodology included group work on the microplanning tools. The participants later developed plans for conducting similar trainings at the district and town level.
