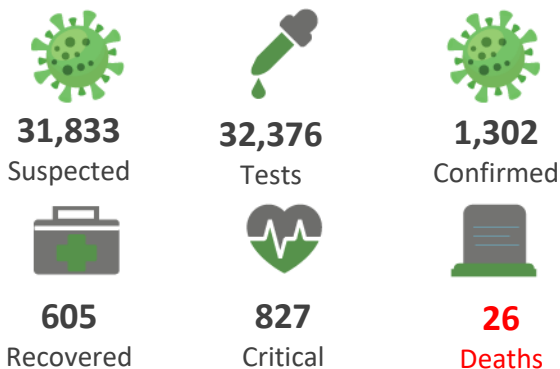


DAILY INCIDENCE BY PROVINCE



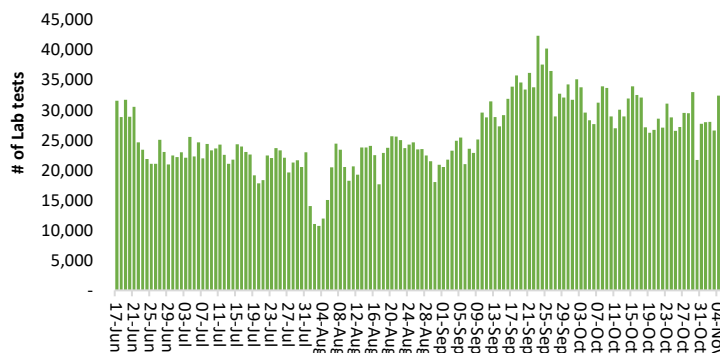
Pakistan reported **1,302** new cases of COVID-19 on **04 November 2020**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **338,875** with **6,893** deaths (**CFR: 2.03%**). Out of the total **15,317** currently active cases, **1,007** cases are hospitalized, out of which **827 (82.12%)** are in critical condition.

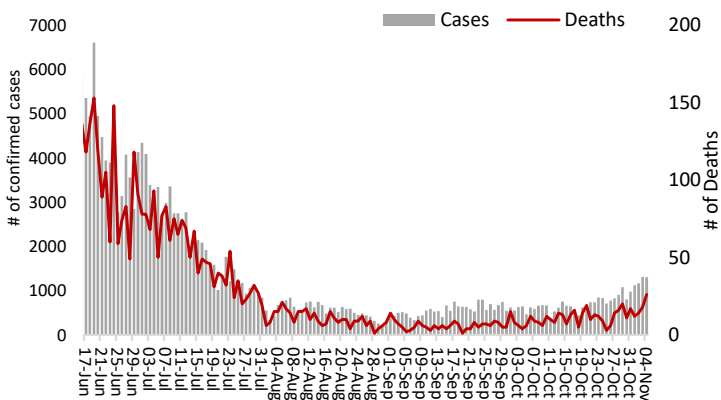

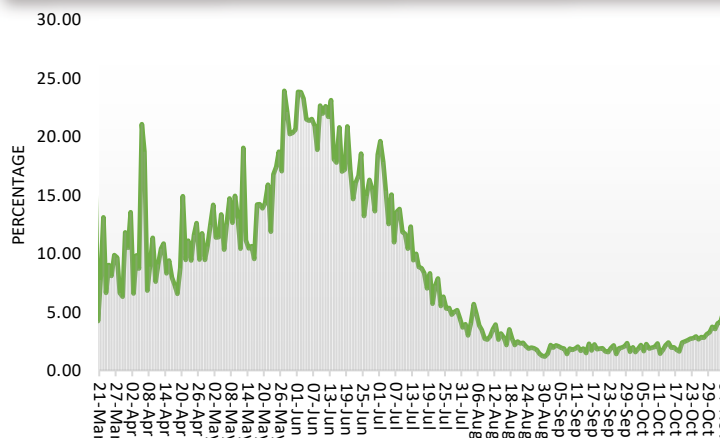


INCIDENCE & DEATHS BY DATE

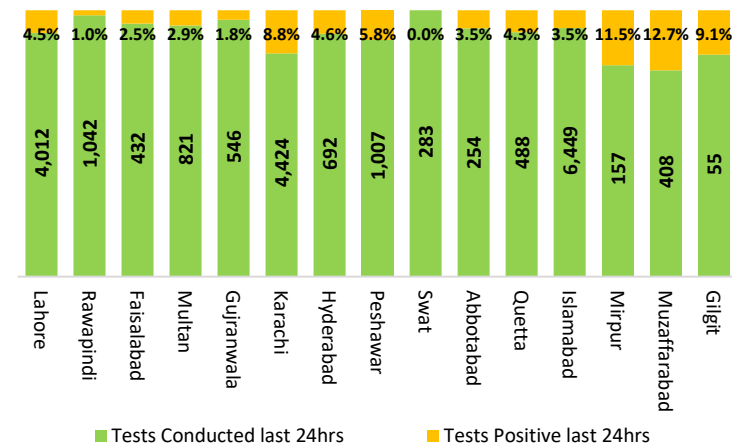
