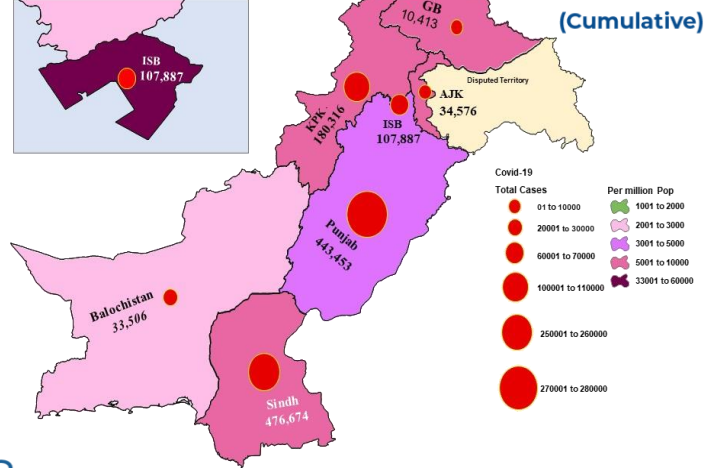

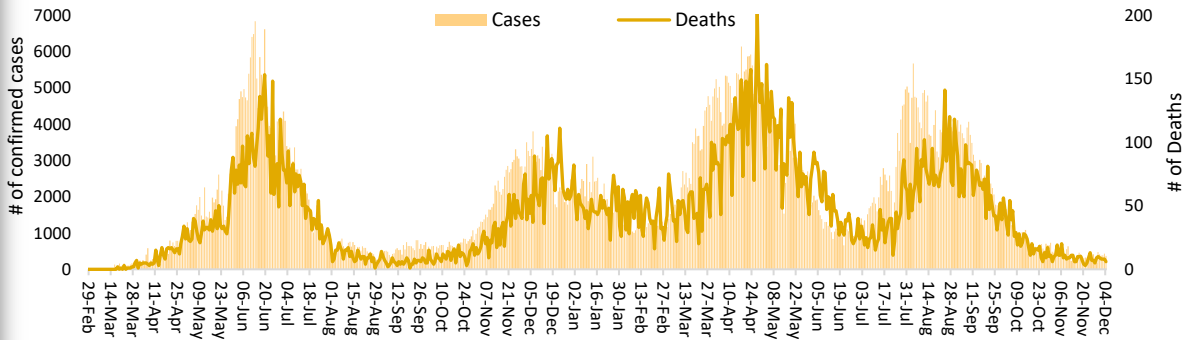

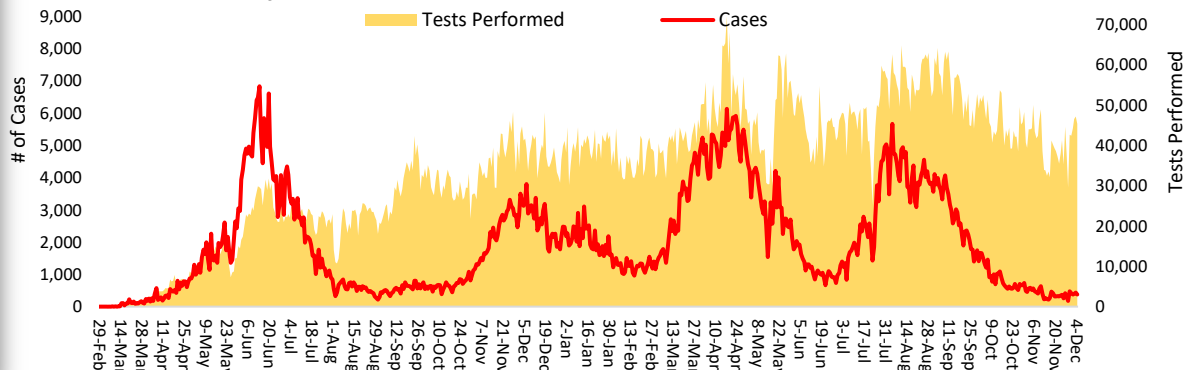

On 3rd December 2021, Ministry of National Health Services, Regulations & Coordination (MoNHSR&C) in collaboration with World Health Organization Pakistan commemorated the International Day of Persons with Disabilities at the Aiwan-e-Sadr, Islamabad. President of Pakistan H.E Dr. Arif Alvi graced the event. Other dignitaries at the ceremony were WHO Country Representative Pakistan, Dr Palitha Mahipala, Vice chancellor Health Services Academy, Dr Shahzad Ali Khan, Officials from MoNHSR&C and WHO staff.

In his remarks, Dr Palitha underscored the importance of an inclusive health systems in the quest for attainment of national and global health priorities; He reiterated WHO commitment to promoting health rights of persons with disabilities. The President Dr Alvi launched the survey report on Rapid Assistive Technology Assessment (RATA). He appreciated WHO Pakistan for supporting the RATA in the country.
