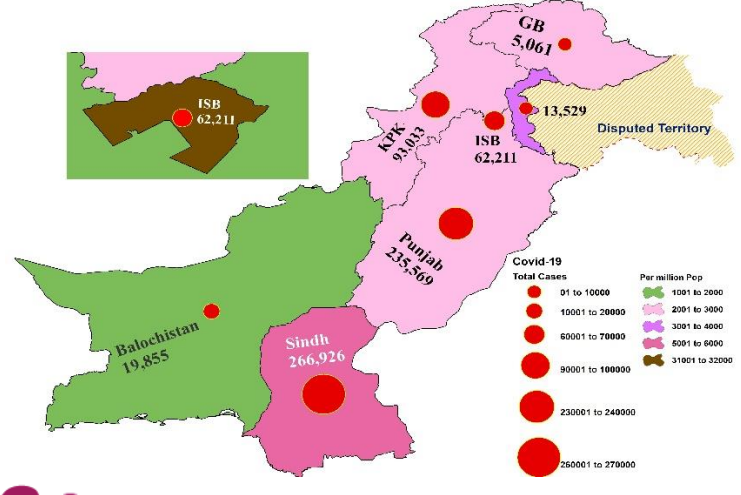
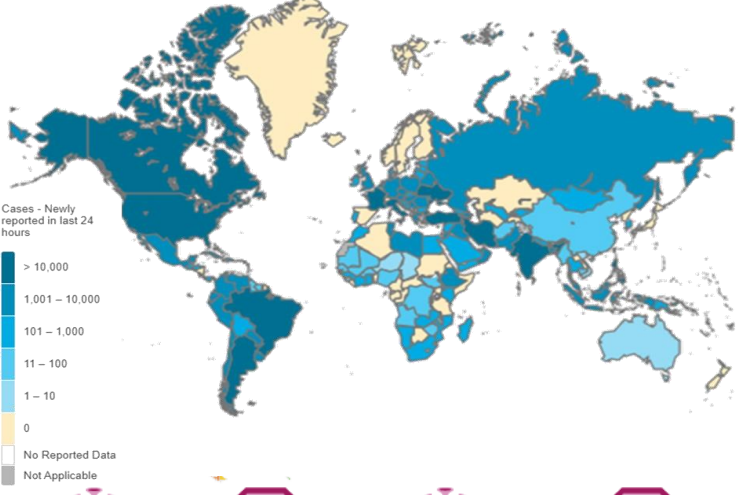

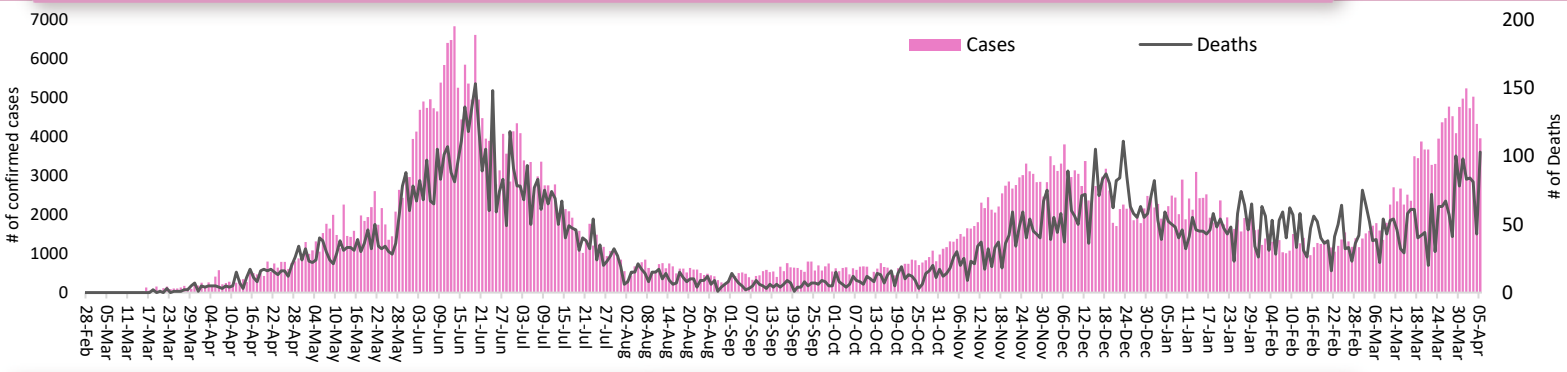

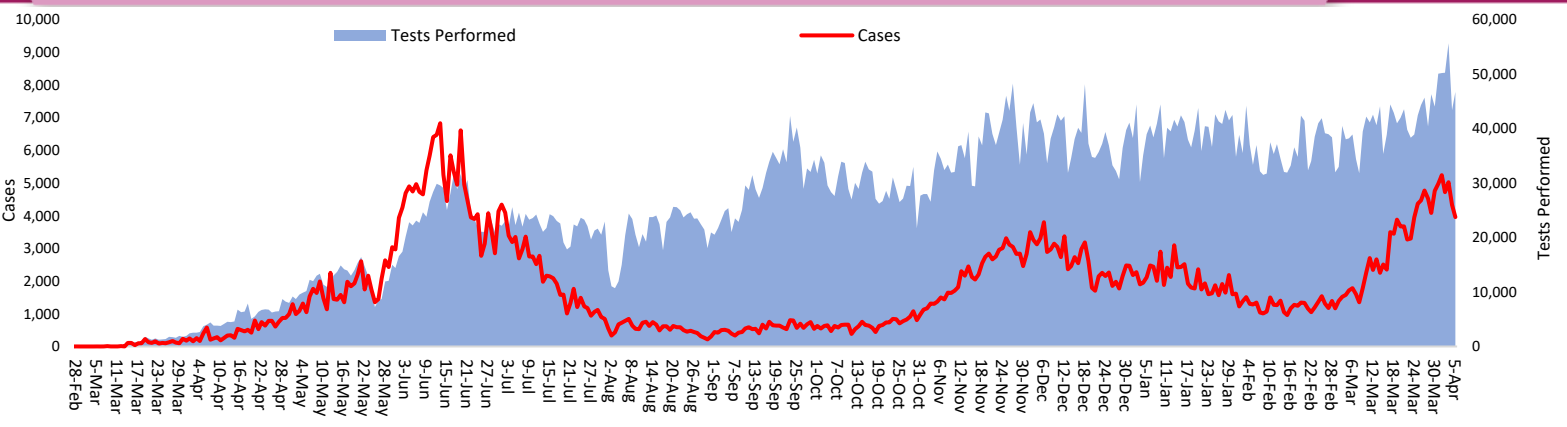

MEETING AND COORDINATION



On 5th April 2021, WHO Country Representative Pakistan, Dr Palitha Mahipala along with Special Assistant to Prime Minister (SAPM), Ministry of National Health Services, Regulations & Coordination H.E Dr Faisal Sultan visited and inaugurated the Covid-19 vaccination center for senior citizens and persons with disabilities located at Tarlai, Islamabad. The Director General Health, MoNHSRC Dr Rana Safdar and District Health Officer, Dr Zaem, National Programme Manager EPI, Dr. Muhammad Akram Shah and EPI Team lead WHO, Dr Osama Mere attended the inauguration ceremony.
