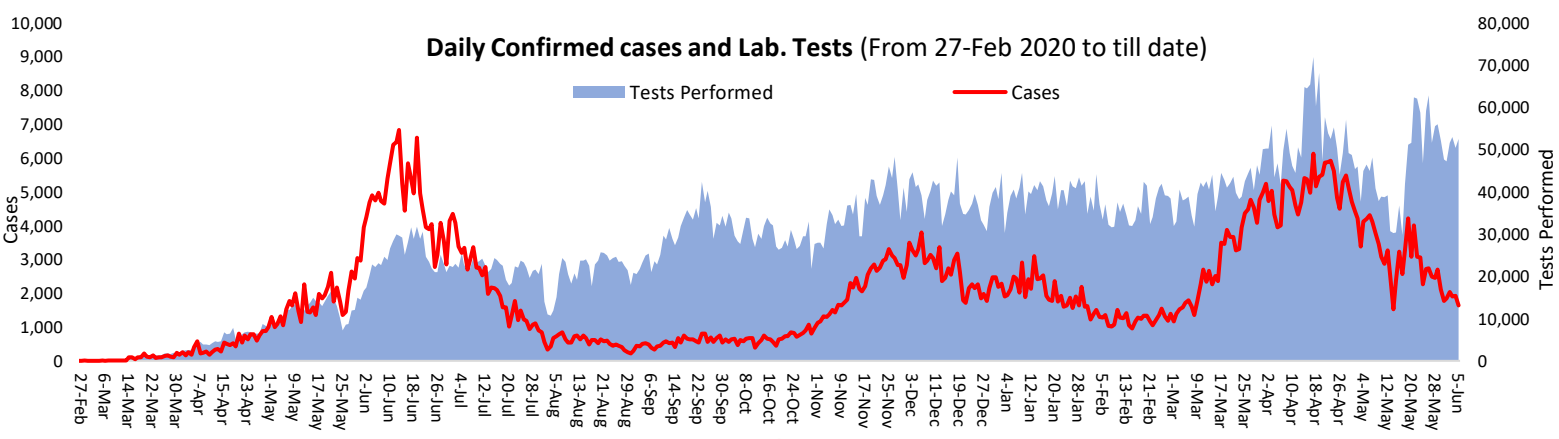

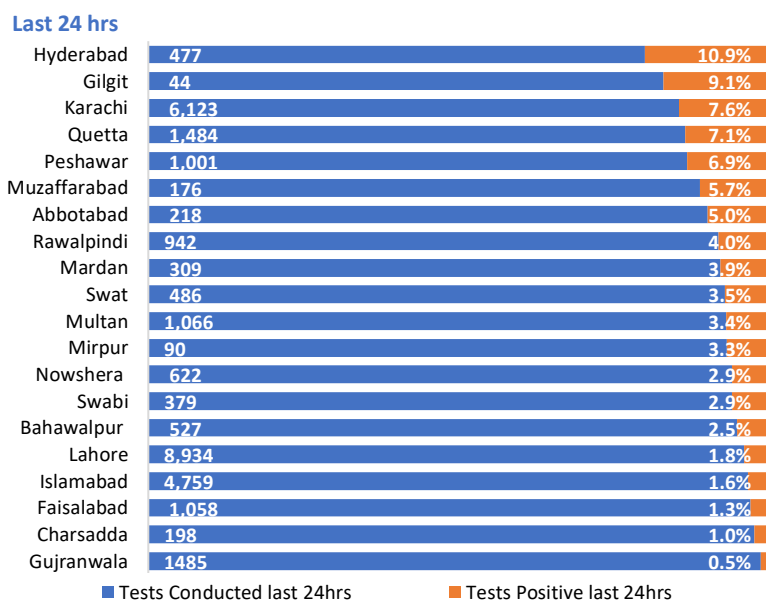
## Meeting and Coordination



On 4<sup>th</sup> June 2021, WHO Country Representative Pakistan, Dr Palitha Mahipala met with the Director Central Health Establishments (CHE) Dr Shaista Habibullah at WHO country office Islamabad. The purpose of the meeting was to discuss screening of travelers at points of entry and contact tracing. The meeting was attended by Dr Nadia Jamil, CHE, and Dr Farah Sabih NPO IHR.

The WR informed the meeting that given the emergence of new SARS CoV2 variants of concern (VoC) there is need for countries to establish stringent measures at Points of Entry (PoEs) for detection of cases and tracing of contact. Dr Palitha reiterated the WHO commitment and technical support in provision of HR, IT equipment and training of staff in data management. This is to enhance capacity to cope with the workload.
