





INCIDENCE & DEATHS BY DATE




DAILY INCIDENCE BY PROVINCE




Pakistan reported **1,376** new cases of COVID-19 on **05 November 2020**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **340,251** with **6,923** deaths **(CFR: 2.03%)**. Out of the total **16,242** currently active cases, **995** cases are hospitalized.

LAB TEST CONDUCTED BY DATE




