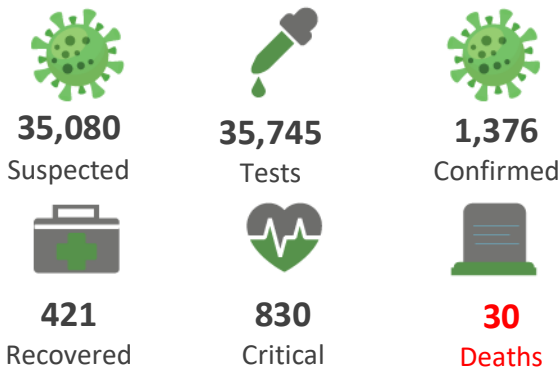


### DAILY INCIDENCE BY PROVINCE



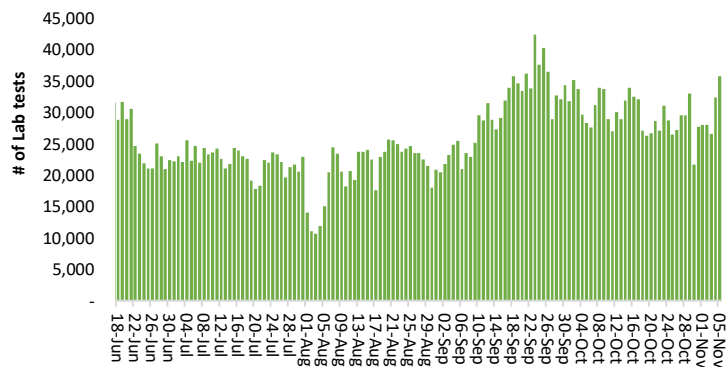
Pakistan reported **1,376** new cases of COVID-19 on **05 November 2020**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **340,251** with **6,923** deaths (CFR: **2.03%**). Out of the total **16,242** currently active cases, **995** cases are hospitalized.

### PAKISTAN UPDATES (Last 24hr)



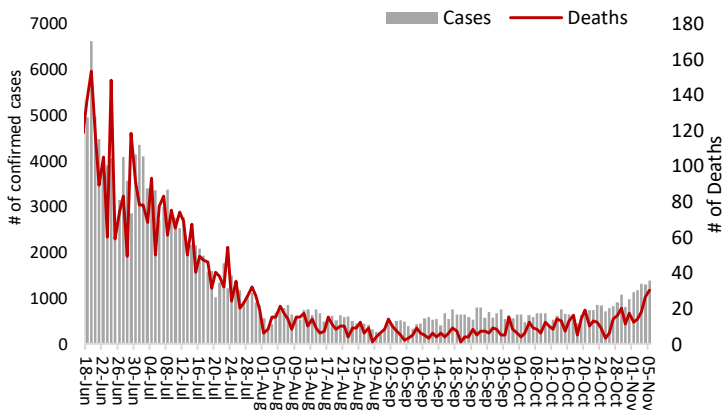

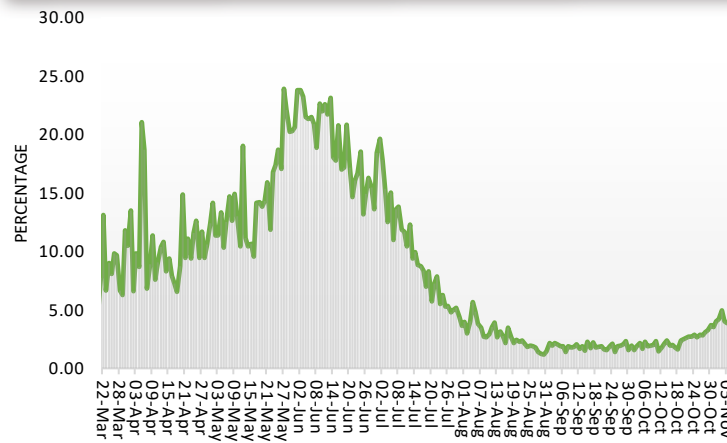


### INCIDENCE & DEATHS BY DATE

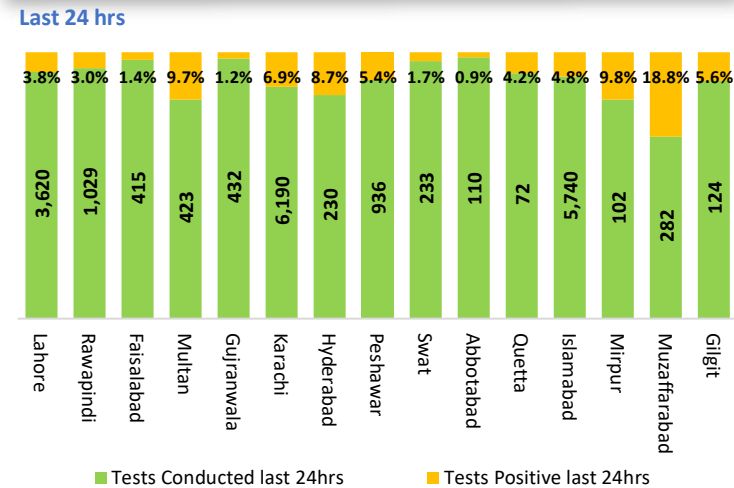
The aim of this donation is to support COVID-19 diagnostic capacity at the National Reference Public Health Laboratory.
