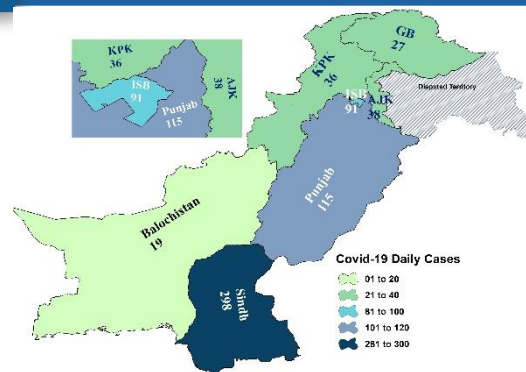

### Executive Summary

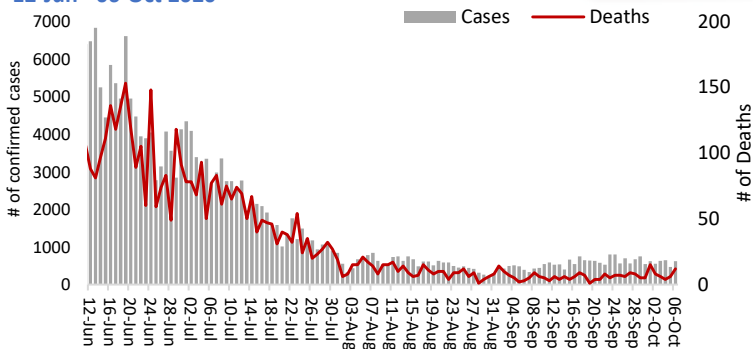
Pakistan reported **624** new cases of COVID-19 on **06 October 2020**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **316,351** with **6,535** deaths (**CFR: 2.07%**). Out of the total **8,528** currently active cases, **787** cases are hospitalized, out of which **499 (63.40%)** are in critical condition. **7,741** COVID-19 positive cases are at designated isolation facilities or in-home isolation. A total of **301,288 (95.23%)** have recovered and discharged.

### Daily Incidence by Province



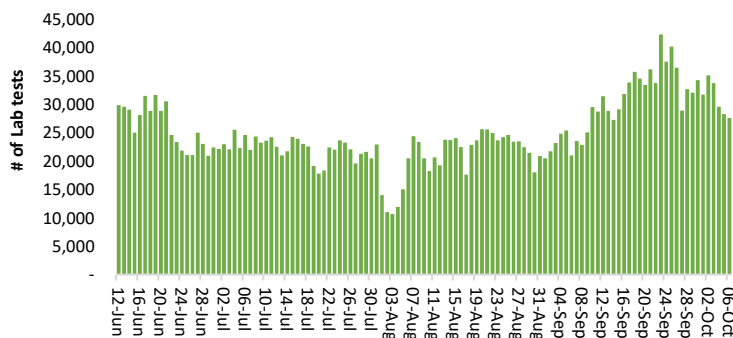
### Daily Incidence/Mortality

12-Jun - 06-Oct 2020

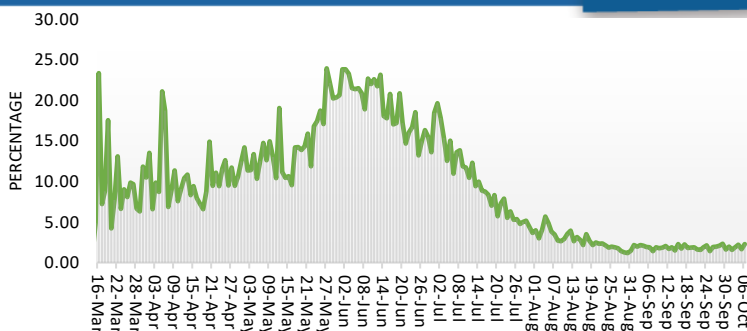


### Daily Lab Test conducted

12-Jun to 06-Oct 2020

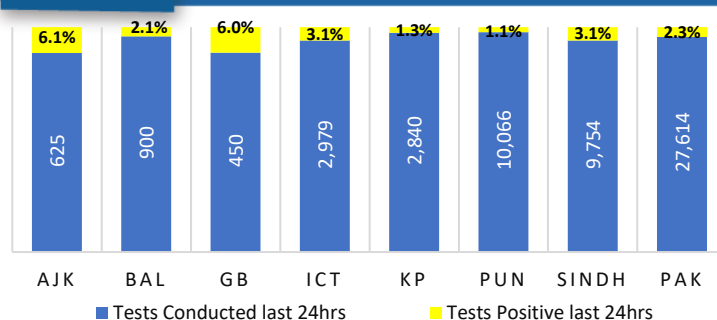


### Daily COVID-19 Positivity Rate

## Meetings & Coordination



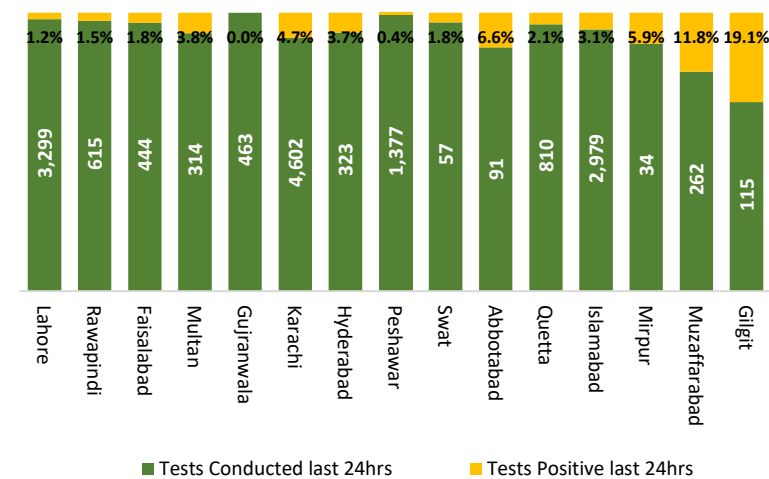
