


TOTAL CASES & CASES PER MILLION POP.




Pakistan reported **3,795** new cases of COVID-19 on **06 December 2020**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **420,294** with **8,398** deaths (**CFR: 2.00%**). Out of the total **55,354** currently active cases **3,094** cases are hospitalized.



09-Jul to 06-Dec 2020




INCIDENCE & DEATHS BY DATE

MEETINGS & COORDINATION


Today, 7th December 2020, WHO country representative Pakistan Dr Palitha Mahipala participated in the inaugural session of the Resource Mobilization Workshop at Margalla Hotel Islamabad.

The objective of the workshop was to appreciate resource mobilization works and how WHO is funded, to get a better sense of what donors are looking for and the key elements required to build and sustain relationships for longer-term, multi-year donor funding. The importance of impact and outcome-related reporting to donors was also highlighted during the workshop.

In his inaugural speech the WR said that Communications and Resource Mobilization should go hand in hand to make the activities visible. He highlighted that WHO enjoys good credibility with the development partners and because of this they always come forward to support WHO's work.
