

Summary Table by Province

On 4th December 2021, WHO Country Representative Pakistan Dr Palitha Mahipala inaugurated an exhibition organized by Association of People Living with HIV (APLHIV) to commemorate the World AIDS Day-2021. The event took place at Lok virsa, Shakarparian, Islamabad. The exhibition was graced by the Project Director Punjab AIDS Control Program, Dr. Faisal Masood and National coordinator APLHIV Mr. Asghar Ilyas Satti.

The APLHIV members organized exhibition of handcrafts and a cultural show with traditional folk dances from different provinces which show cased their means of livelihood and resolved to fight HIV/AIDS related stigma. WHO Pakistan supported voluntary HIV testing during the exhibition.

In his speech, Dr Palitha appreciated the efforts of APLHIV members in empowering communities, creating awareness about HIV/AIDS, and fighting stigma and discrimination in the public domain. He stressed need to hold such events frequently to motivate the concerned communities.
