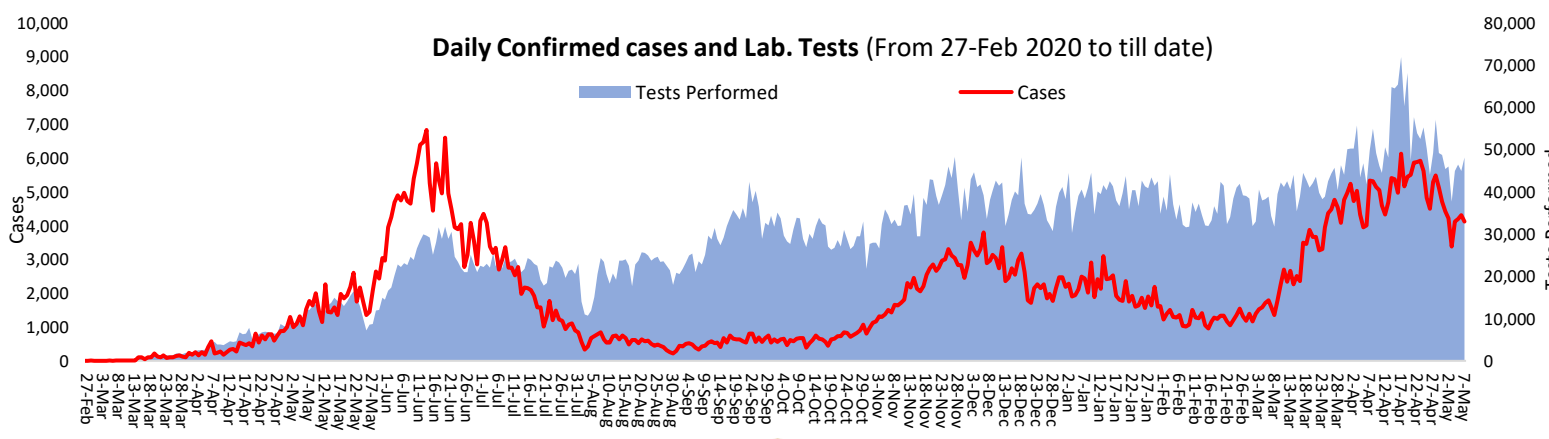

Meeting and Coordination



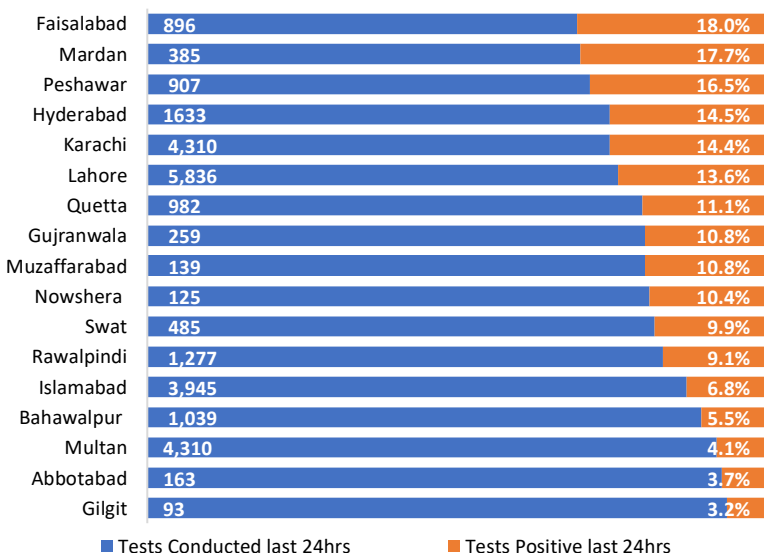
On 7th May 2021, the WHO Country office commemorated World Hand Hygiene day 2021 under the theme; “seconds SAVE LIVES - Clean Your Hands”. Speaking at the occasion, The WHO Country Representative Pakistan, Dr Palitha Mahipala underscored the importance of correct handwashing technique in infection prevention and control, especially in the current context of COVID 19.

The WR reminded staff that the Hand Hygiene day is celebrated every year to maintain promotion, visibility, and sustainability of hand hygiene and, stressed its importance at the point of care, while noting that its practice could potentially enhance reduction in preventable infections by up to 50%.

He commended health facilities in the provinces of; Punjab, KP, Balochistan & ICT for conducting activities to commemorate World hand hygiene day.
