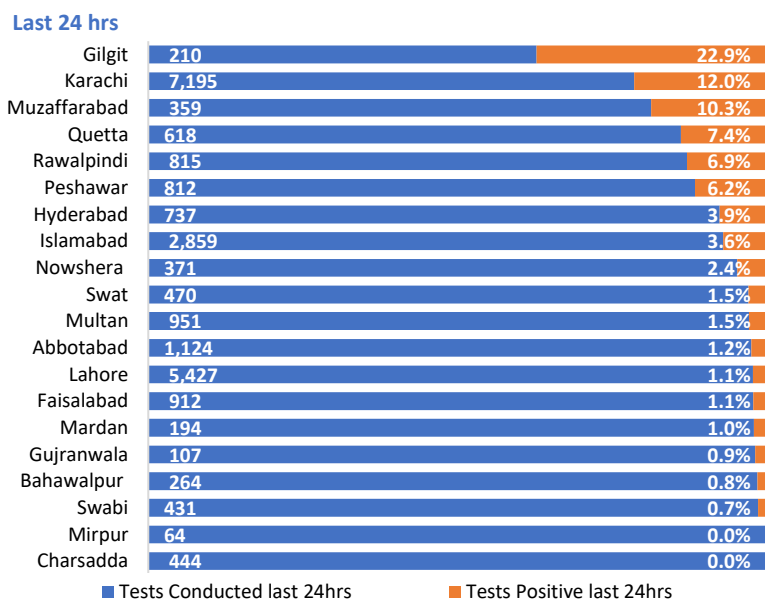

## Meeting and Coordination



On 8th July 2021, WHO Country Representative Pakistan, Dr Palitha Mahipala accompanied by WHO/ Team Lead Expanded Program on Immunization, Dr Osama Mere conducted technical support supervision to Lahore district, Punjab province. The objective of the technical support supervision is to monitor the ongoing measles campaign that is targeting 4.4 million children aged six-months to five years in 41 priority districts of Pakistan. The team visited Al Hajvery Cadet School Gulberg Lahore and was received by District Health Officer, Dr Faisal Malik, Deputy District Health Officer, Gulberg Town Dr Faraz Rasheed and Head of WHO Sub-office Punjab, Dr Jamshaid Ahmed. Dr Palitha appreciated the efforts by school administrators, frontline health workers, and parents in ensuring that all eligible children are vaccinated, as this will contribute to the containment of the measles outbreak. The WR further pledged continued technical support from WHO towards prevention and control of Vaccine Preventable Diseases.
