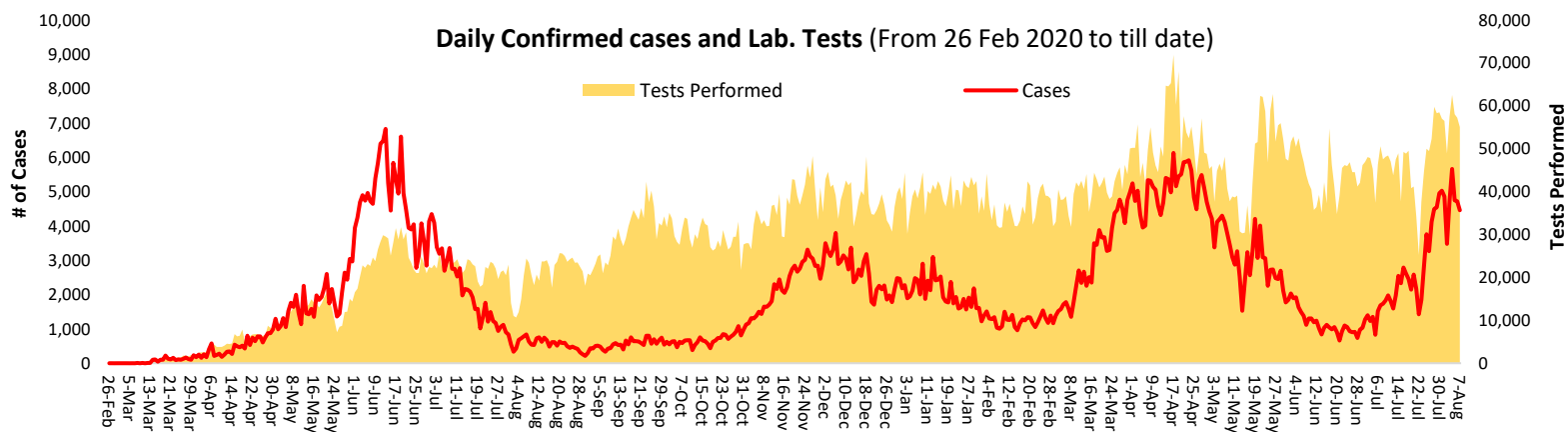

Meetings & Coordination

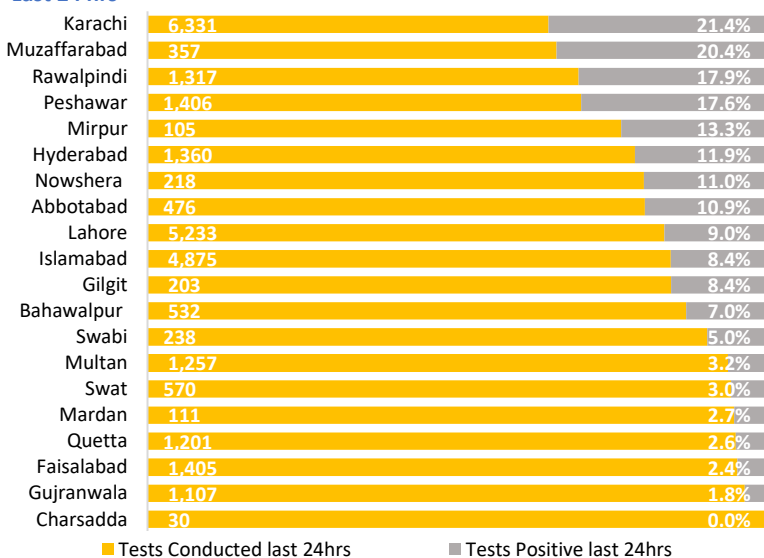


The Provincial Health Department, Balochistan in collaboration with World Health Organization, Pakistan conducted a 7-day training to enhance the quality of Maternal and Newborn health care services through the continuum of care approach i.e., Pregnancy, Childbirth, Postpartum and Newborn Care. The training was conducted from 2nd to 8th August 2021 at Sandeman Provincial Teaching Hospital, Quetta. 24 Health care Providers comprising of Lady Health Visitors, Lady Medical Officers and Gynecologists participated in the training. The participants were drawn from Primary and Secondary healthcare levels from the districts of: Loralai, Killa Abdullah, Quetta, Khuzdar, Kech and Jaffarabad.

In his closing remarks, the Deputy Provincial Coordinator MNCH Program Balochistan, Dr Shaihak Riaz appreciated WHO collaboration and support in enhancing quality of maternal and newborn healthcare.
