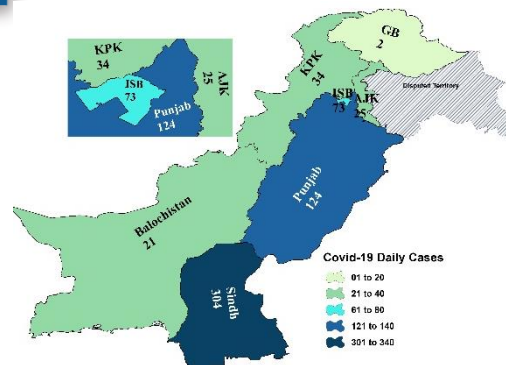

Executive Summary

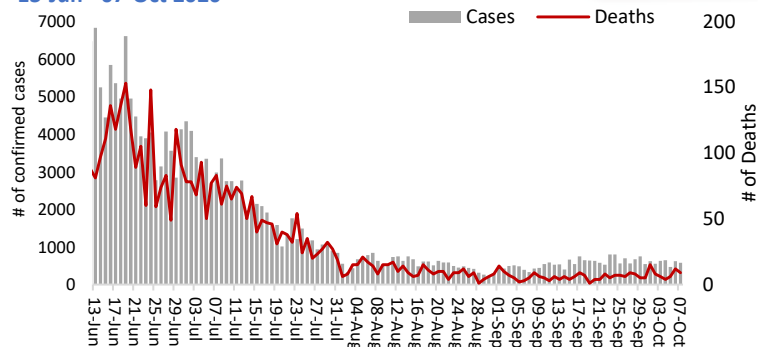
Pakistan reported **583** new cases of COVID-19 on **07 October 2020**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **316,934** with **6,554** deaths (**CFR: 2.07%**). Out of the total **8,015** currently active cases, **744** cases are hospitalized, out of which **497** (**66.80%**) are in critical condition. **7,271** COVID-19 positive cases are at designated isolation facilities or in-home isolation. A total of **302,375** (**95.40%**) have recovered and discharged.

Daily Incidence by Province



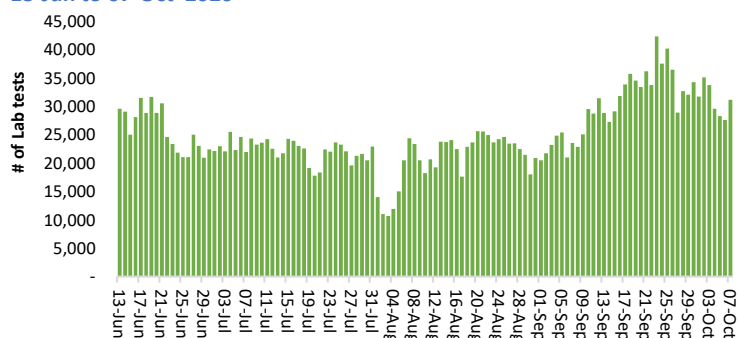
Daily Incidence/Mortality

13-Jun - 07-Oct 2020

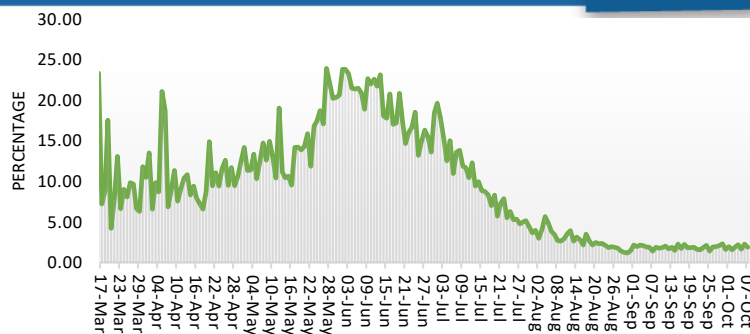


Daily Lab Test conducted

13-Jun to 07-Oct 2020

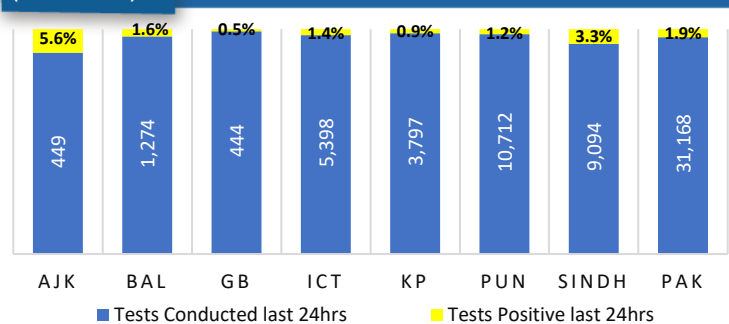


Daily COVID-19 Positivity Rate

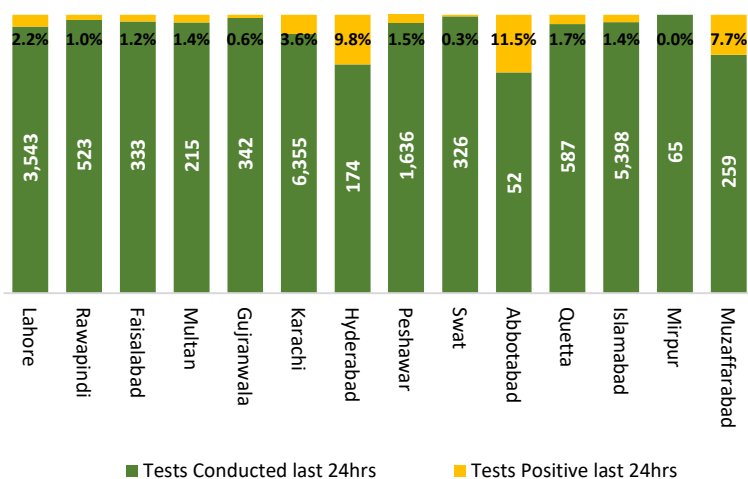
Dr Asfandiyar Sherani, RMNCAH Technical Officer, WHO sub Office Balochistan facilitating discussion in the meeting.

On 6th October 2020, WHO sub-office Balochistan in collaboration with Provincial Health Department Balochistan, conducted a one-day training on the use of mobile application for “Maternal and Perinatal Death Surveillance and Response (MPDSR)” by District Headquarter Teaching Hospital, District Kech and Turbat. The training was followed by the review of maternal deaths from January to June 2020.

The training and review meeting were attended by the Gynecology / Obstetric, Hospital administration and District Health Management team. The purpose of the review meeting and training was to institutionalize the use of mobile application for data collection and relay through MPDSR to the provincial and national level.
