

COVID-19 case density/million Population




Executive Summary

Pakistan reported **842** new cases of COVID-19 on **07 August 2020**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **283,487** with **6,068** deaths (**CFR: 2.14%**). Out of the total **17,815** currently active cases, **1,344** cases are hospitalized, out of which **801 (59.59%)** are in critical condition. **16,471** COVID-19 positive cases are at designated isolation facilities or in-home isolation. A total of **259,604 (91.57%)** have recovered and discharged.


Daily Lab tests conducted in Pakistan

10 May to 07 Aug 2020




Daily incidence of COVID-19 cases in Pakistan




Meeting & Coordination


Daily Positivity rate in Pakistan




Daily Attack rate/million population



Confirmed by Age and Gender




Mortality by Age and Gender






COVID-19 confirmed cases & CFR (%) by districts
