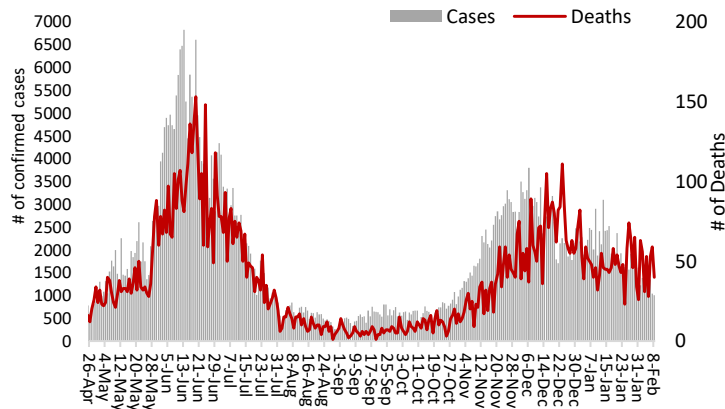

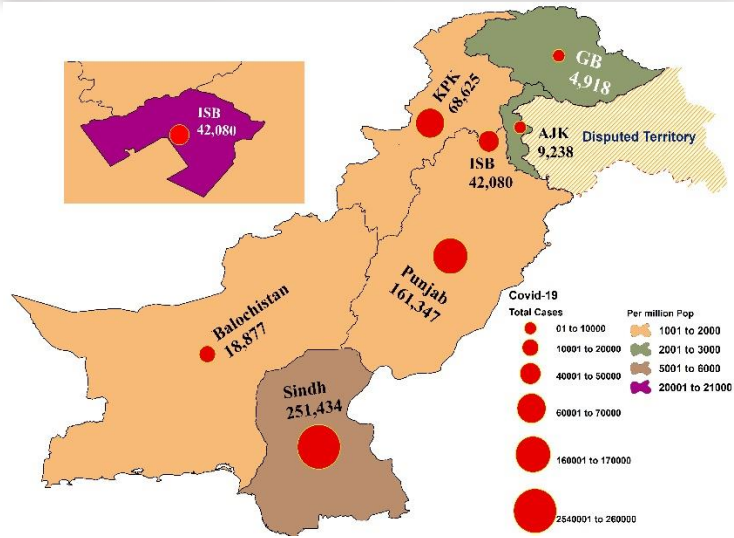


INCIDENCE & DEATHS BY DATE

26-April 2020 - 08- Feb 2021



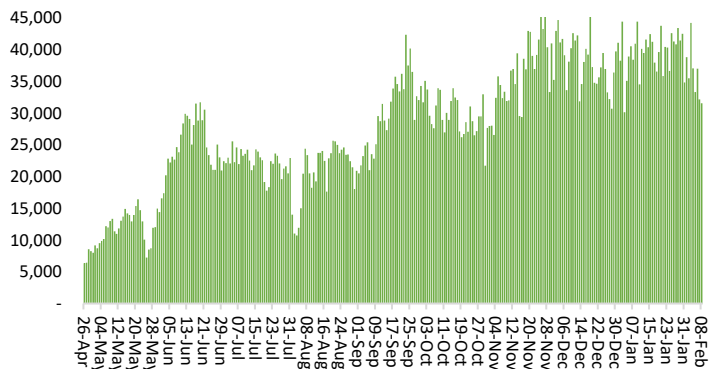
TOTAL CASES & CASES PER MILLION POP.



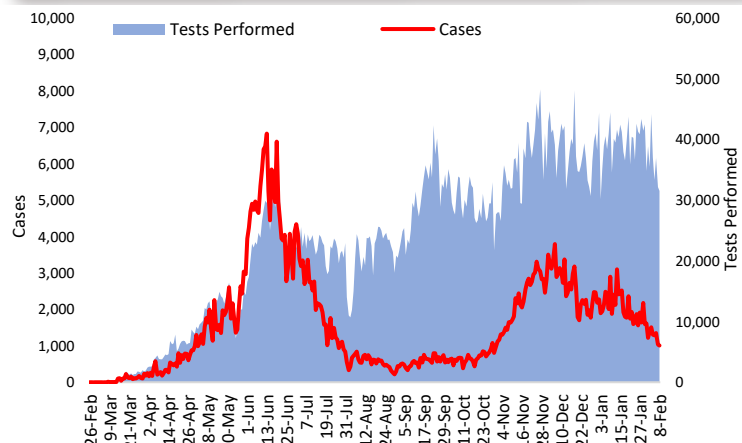
Pakistan reported **1,008** new cases of COVID-19 on **8th February 2021**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **556,519** with **12,066** deaths (**CFR: 2.17%**). Out of the total **31,510** currently active cases **2,219** cases are hospitalized.

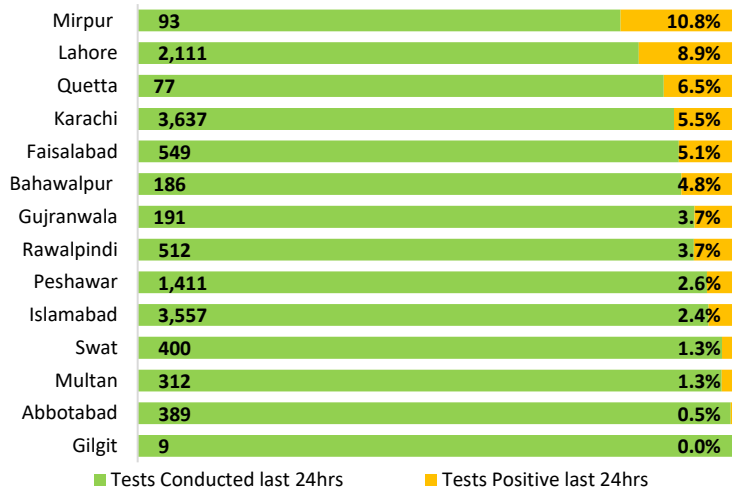
