## Meeting and Coordination



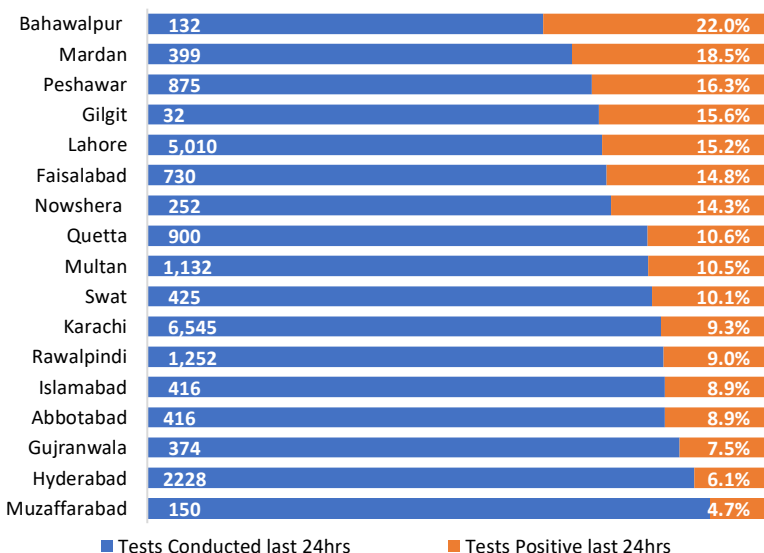
On 8<sup>th</sup> May 2021, Pakistan received the first shipment of Oxford-AstraZeneca COVID-19 vaccines (SII-AZ AZD1222) from the COVAX Facility, that is the vaccine pillar of the ACT accelerator tool launched by WHO to fast track the development and manufacture of COVID 19 vaccines, and to guarantee fair and equitable access for every country in the world.

COVAX, a global partnership, is co-led by the World Health Organization (WHO); Gavi, the Vaccine Alliance; and the Coalition for Epidemic Preparedness Innovations (CEPI), alongside key delivery partner, the United Nations Children's Fund (UNICEF). It is funded by support from governments, foundations, and private sector corporations.

On the Occasion, WHO Country Representative Pakistan, Dr Palitha Mahipala appreciated COVAX facility for the vaccines donation and reiterated WHO continued commitment to the COVID 19 response. The WR, thanked the Government of Pakistan for taking lead in the Vaccination program and further appreciated the health care workers for their commitment and dedication to the COVID-19 response.
