



INCIDENCE & DEATHS BY DATE




TOTAL CASES & CASES PER MILLION POP.




Pakistan reported **2,899** new cases of COVID-19 on **09 January 2021**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **502,416** with **10,644** deaths **(CFR: 2.12%)**. Out of the total **34,803** currently active cases **2,804** cases are hospitalized.
