


## PAKISTAN COVID-19 SITUATION REPORT



## **Meetings & Coordination**



On 10<sup>th</sup> August 2021, Provincial Health Department, Sindh in collaboration with World Health Organization Pakistan conducted an orientation on COVID-19, SARI/ILI and IHR (2005) requirements. The orientation was facilitated by technical officers from WHO Pakistan and moderated by Secretary Continuous Medical Education (CME), Indus hospital, Ms. Fariha Aziz. The orientation was conducted at Korangi Campus, Indus Hospital, Karachi.

Over 60 health workers participated in the training physically and via zoom link. The participants were Physicians, Nurses and Post graduate Trainees of General Medicine, Pediatric Medicine, Chest Medicine, Family Medicine, and Infectious Diseases drawn from Indus hospital and its health facilities network. At the end of training, Ms. Fariha thanked WHO Pakistan for supporting the training.
