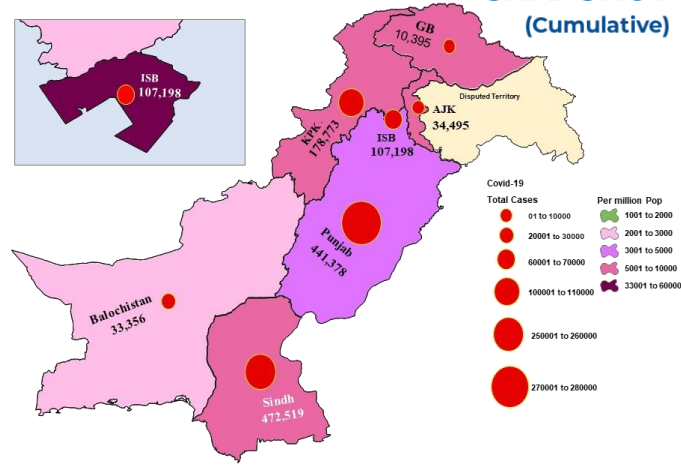

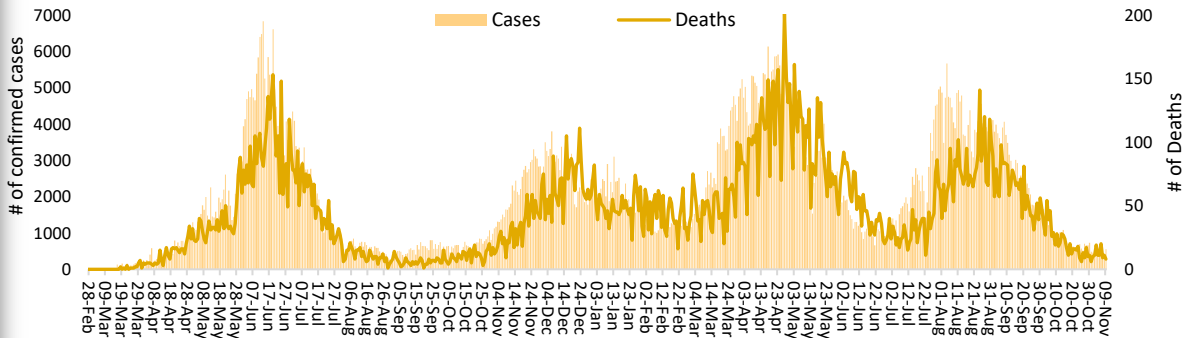

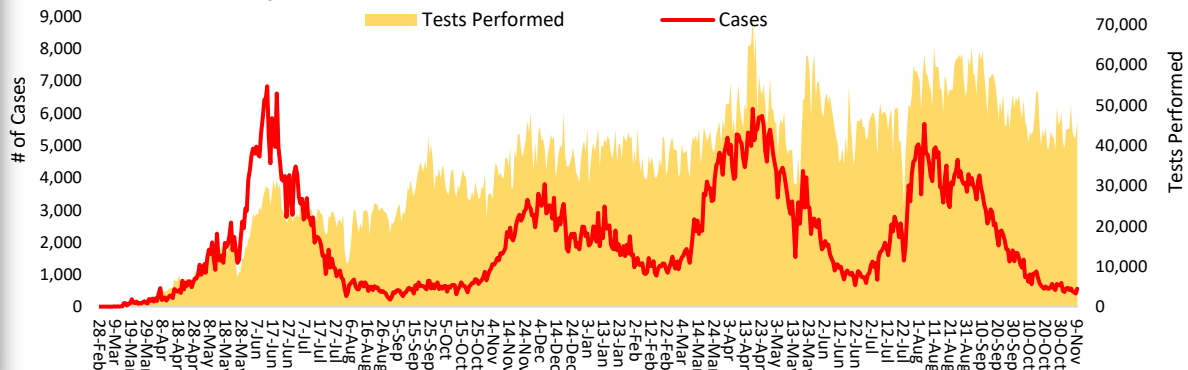

On 10th November 2021, WHO Country Representative Pakistan Dr Palitha Mahipala and the Ambassador of the Royal Embassy of Thailand H.E Mr Chakkrid Krachaiwong participated in a joint awareness campaign against Dengue at The Royal Thai embassy Islamabad.
