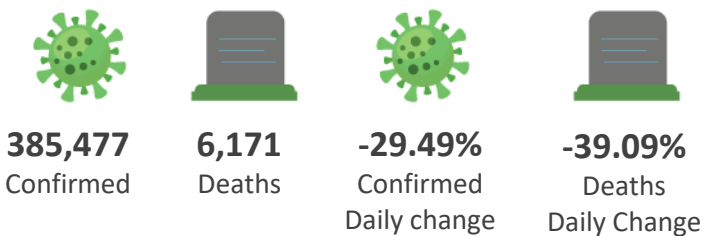


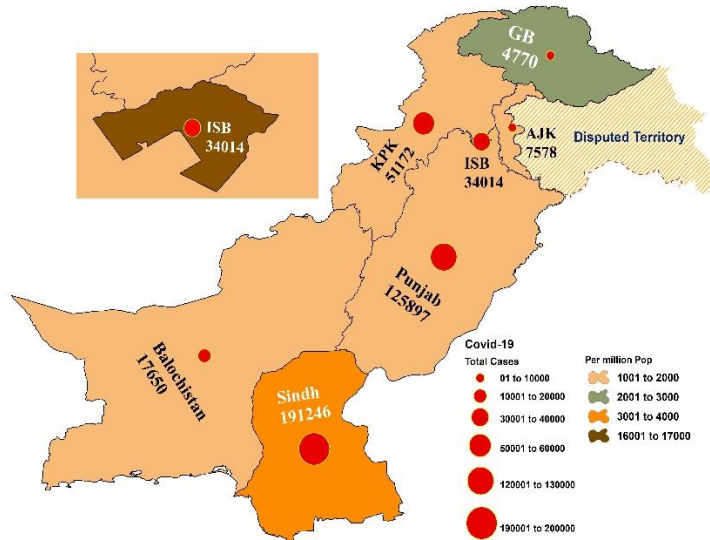

### GLOBAL UPDATES (Last 24hr)

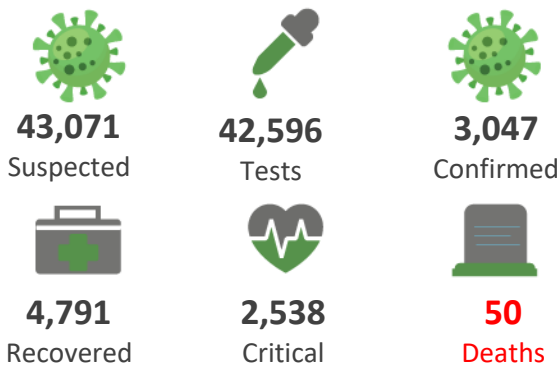


### TOTAL CASES & CASES PER MILLION POP.



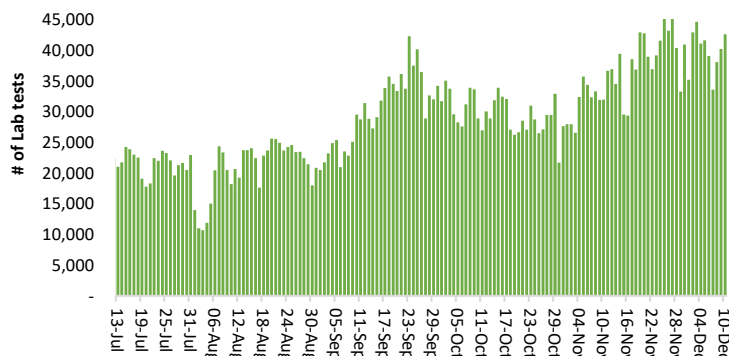
Pakistan reported **3,047** new cases of COVID-19 on **10 December 2020**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **432,327** with **8,653** deaths (**CFR: 2.00%**). Out of the total **44,582** currently active cases **3,128** cases are hospitalized.

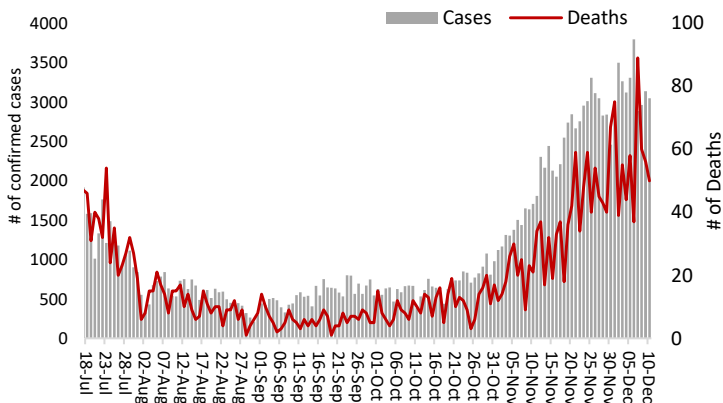
### LAB TEST CONDUCTED BY DATE

13-Jul to 10-Dec 2020

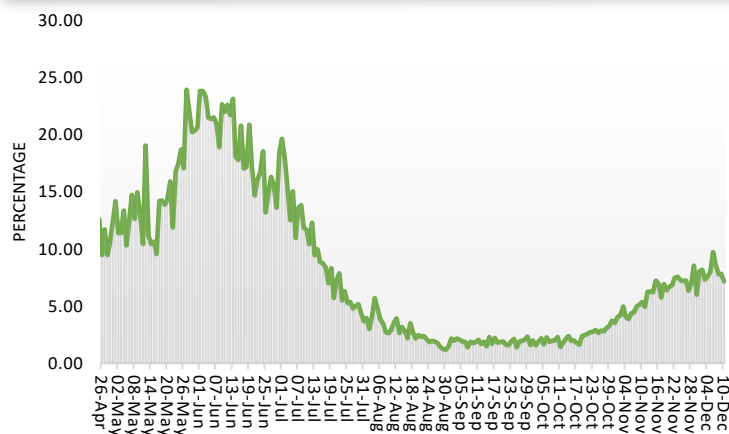


### INCIDENCE & DEATHS BY DATE

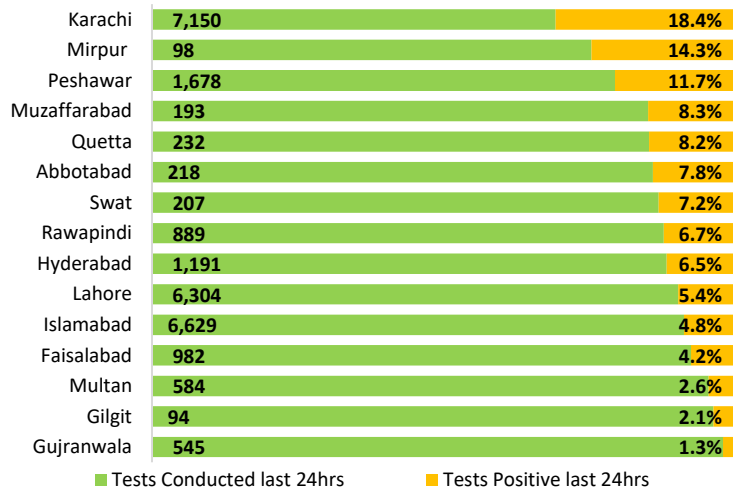
