



INCIDENCE & DEATHS BY DATE




TOTAL CASES & CASES PER MILLION POP.




Pakistan reported **2,408** new cases of COVID-19 on **11 January 2021**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **506,701** with **10,717** deaths **(CFR: 2.11%)**. Out of the total **34,007** currently active cases **2,843** cases are hospitalized.
