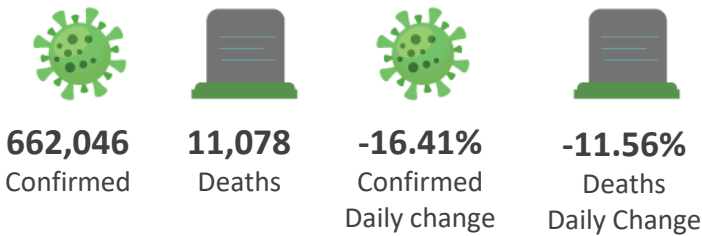
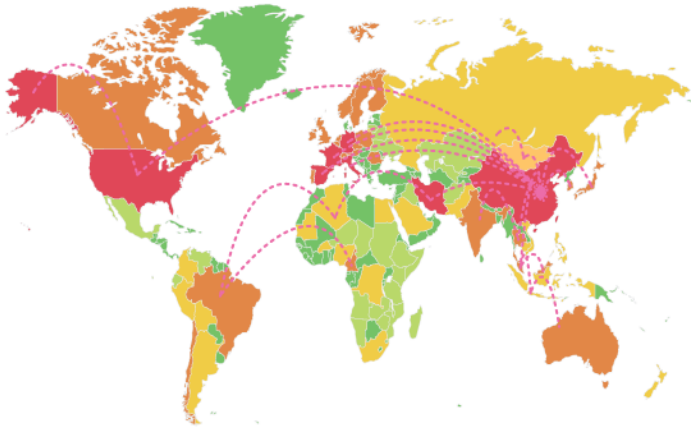


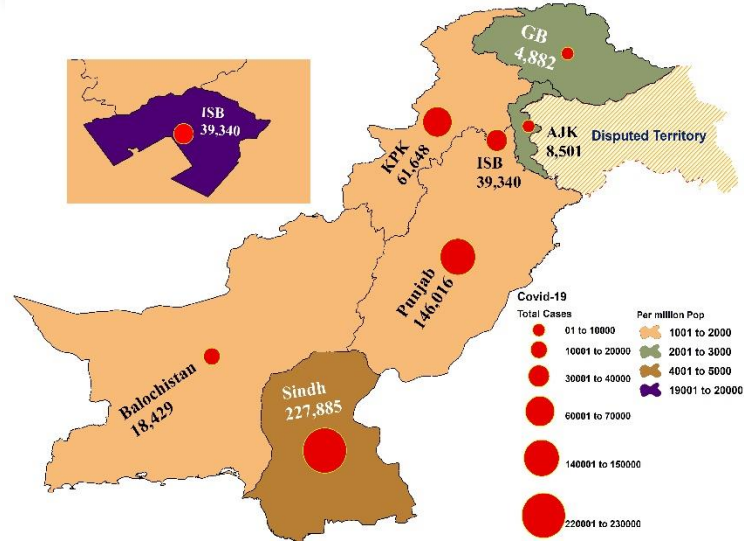

### GLOBAL UPDATES (Last 24hr)

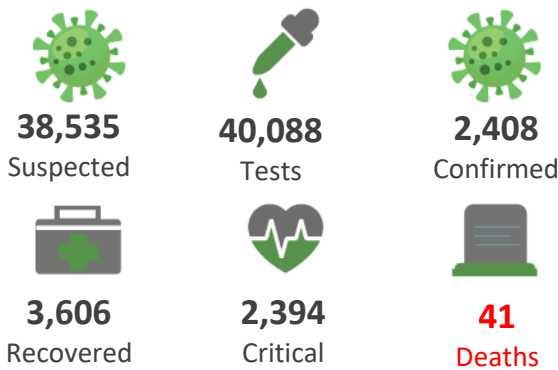


### TOTAL CASES & CASES PER MILLION POP.



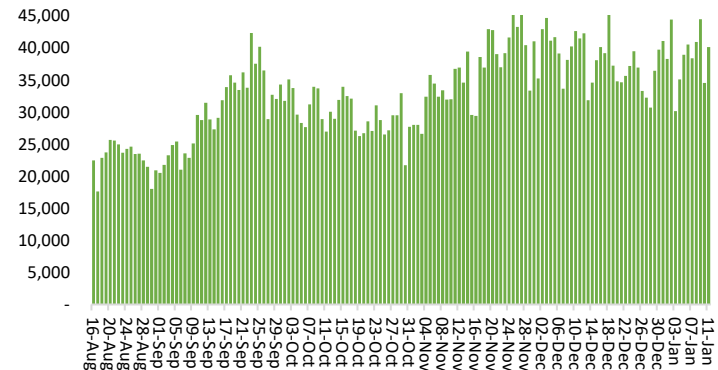
Pakistan reported **2,408** new cases of COVID-19 on **11 January 2021**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **506,701** with **10,717** deaths (**CFR: 2.11%**). Out of the total **34,007** currently active cases **2,843** cases are hospitalized.

### PAKISTAN UPDATES (Last 24hr)



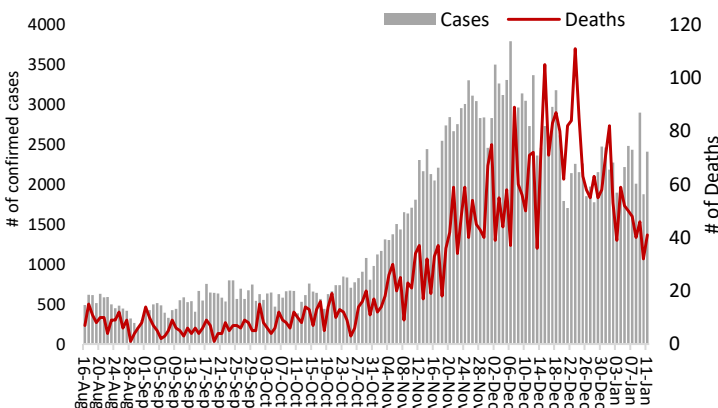
### LAB TEST (PCR + RA) CONDUCTED BY DATE

16-Aug 2020 - 11-Jan 2021

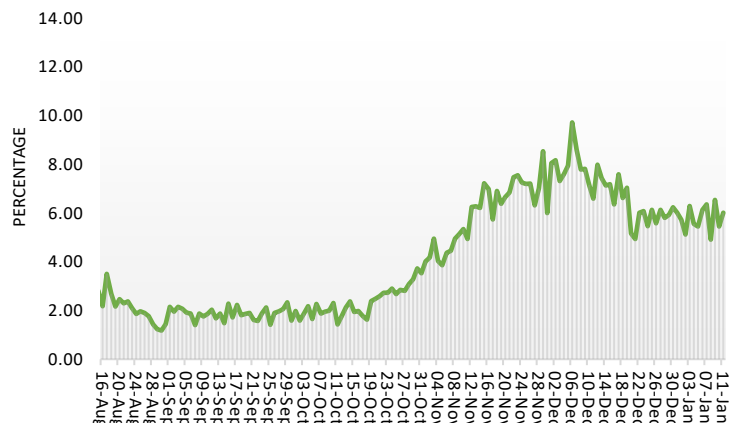


### INCIDENCE & DEATHS BY DATE

## MEETINGS & COORDINATION

On 12 January, WHO Country Representative Pakistan, Dr Palitha Mahipala visited Karachi district East to observe the polio and routine immunization activities.
