

Executive Summary


Pakistan reported **385** new cases of COVID-19 on **11 October 2020**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **319,317** with **6,580** deaths (**CFR: 2.06%**). Out of the total **8,552** currently active cases, **804** cases are hospitalized, out of which **491 (61.07%)** are in critical condition. **7,748** COVID-19 positive cases are at designated isolation facilities or in-home isolation. A total of **304,185 (95.26%)** have recovered and discharged.

Daily Incidence by Province




Daily Incidence/Mortality

13-Jun - 11-Oct 2020




Daily Lab Test conducted




Daily COVID-19 Positivity Rate


