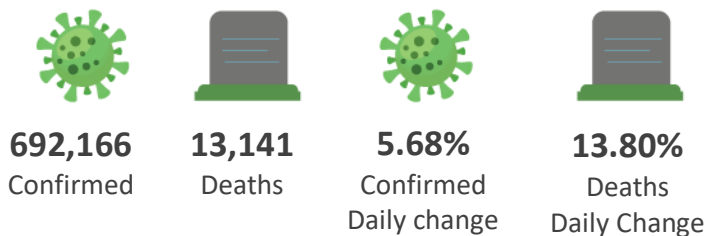


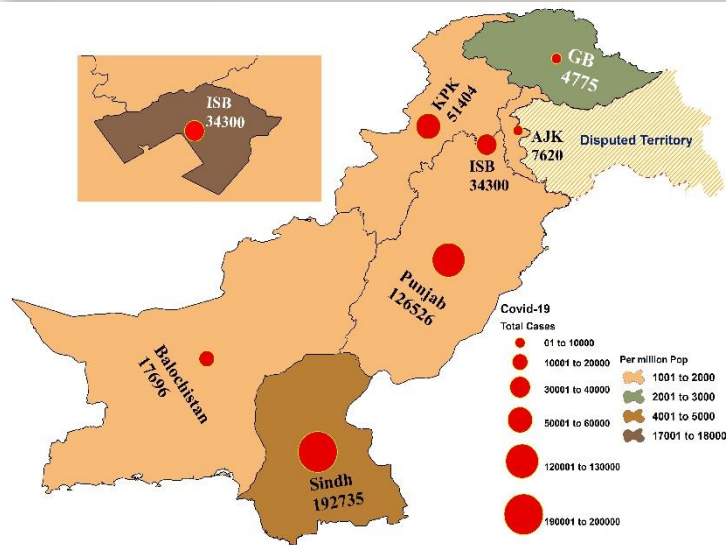

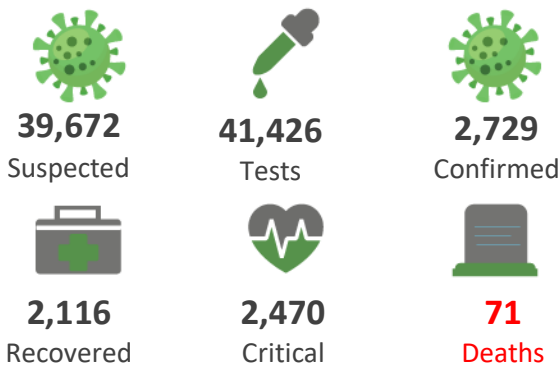


TOTAL CASES & CASES PER MILLION POP.



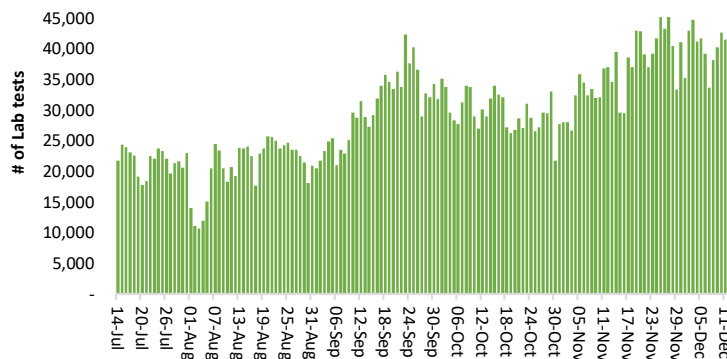
Pakistan reported **2,729** new cases of COVID-19 on **11 December 2020**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **435,056** with **8,724** deaths (**CFR: 2.00%**). Out of the total **45,124** currently active cases **3,026** cases are hospitalized.

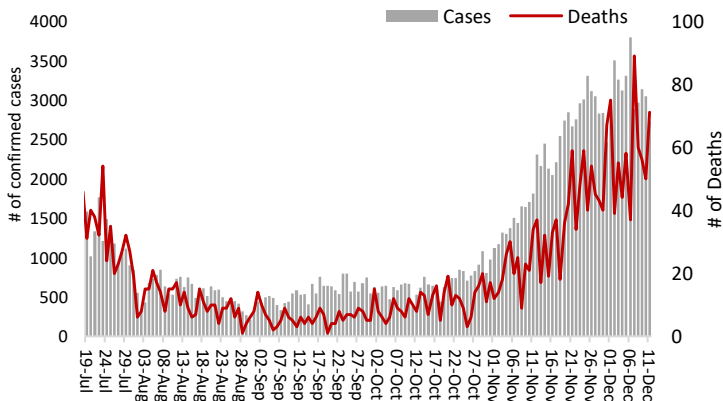
LAB TEST CONDUCTED BY DATE

14-Jul to 11-Dec 2020

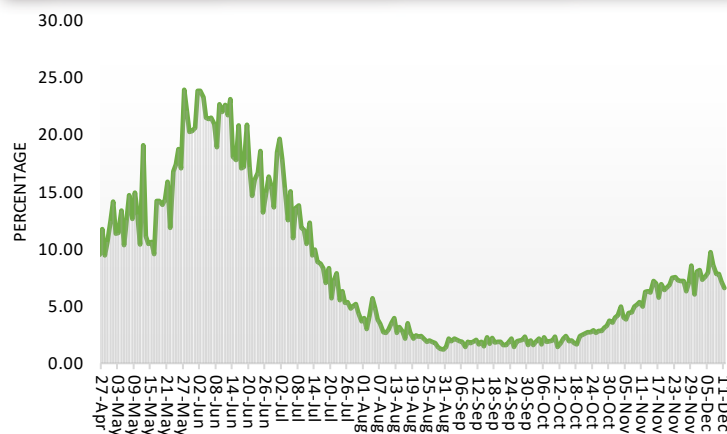


INCIDENCE & DEATHS BY DATE

MEETINGS & COORDINATION

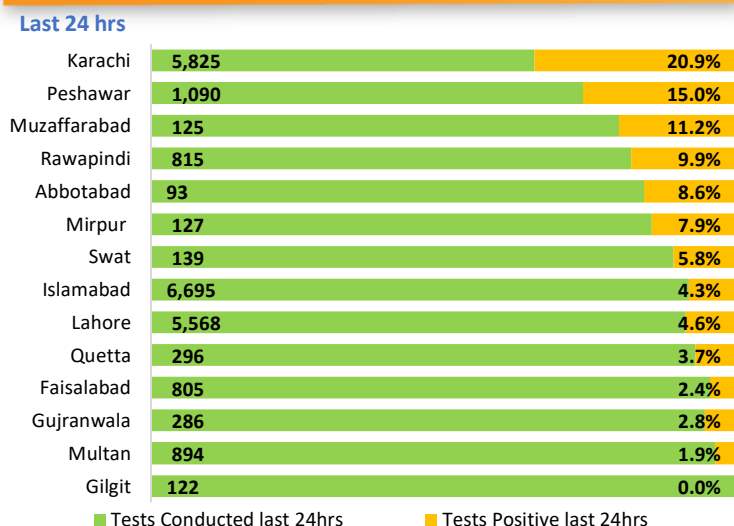
Yesterday, 11th December 2020, The WHO Country Representative Pakistan, Dr Palitha Mahipala met with the Director General Health Services Sindh Dr Irshad Ahmed Memon in his office in Hyderabad. The Vice Chancellor of Liaquat University of Medical and Health Sciences, Prof. Bikha Ram Devrajani also attended the meeting. During the meeting Dr Irshad briefed the WR on the current COVID-19 situation and the floods response in the province. Dr Palitha later handed over assortments of medical supplies for early essential newborn care to the vice chancellor Liaquat University of Medical and Health Sciences.

After the meeting, Dr Palitha visited the District Health Office Umarnkot and met with the DHO Dr Allah Dad Rathore and handed over 100 tents and 3,000 mosquito nets for the floods affected population. He also handed over 250 tents and 9,000 mosquito nets to the DGHS for the floods affected families.

After the visit to the DHO office Dr Palitha later visited Taluka Hospital Samaro in Umerkot district and handed over an ambulance to the Medical Superintendent Dr Kelash Kumar. While talking to the media at THQ hospital Samaro, Director General Health Services expressed his gratitude to WHO for their continued support to Pakistan in combating COVID-19 outbreak and supporting response to the flood.

Dr Palitha Mahipala WHO Country Representative Pakistan visited the Director General Health Services Sindh, **Dr Irshad Ahmed Memon**. The two later went for a field visit to the district Umarnkot, Sindh. They were accompanied by other officials from Sindh Province.
