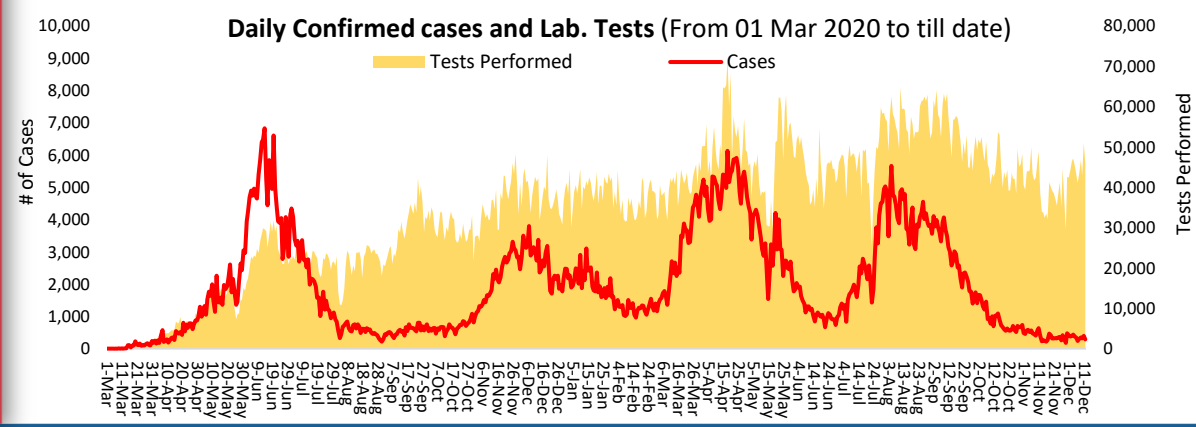

On 10th December 2021, WHO Country Representative Pakistan Dr Palitha Mahipala chaired a meeting between the WHO and UNFPA Pakistan technical teams. The meeting took place at WHO Country Office Islamabad. Deputy Representative UNFPA, Dr Bokhtior Kadirov, led the UNFPA team.

The objective of the meeting was to discuss and explore areas of mutual interest for bilateral cooperation and joint working. During the meeting It was agreed to collaborate in UHC-benefit package implementation, LHW strategy development, Sexual and Reproductive Health and Rights programming, gender-based violence and midwifery strengthening. The technical teams would develop mapping matrix for each agency's current scope in the identified areas and in a follow up meeting the mapping matrix will be reviewed for mutual collaboration.

Dr Palitha in his remarks appreciated the government's commitment to universal health insurance across the country and reaffirmed the WHO support to the government of Pakistan.
