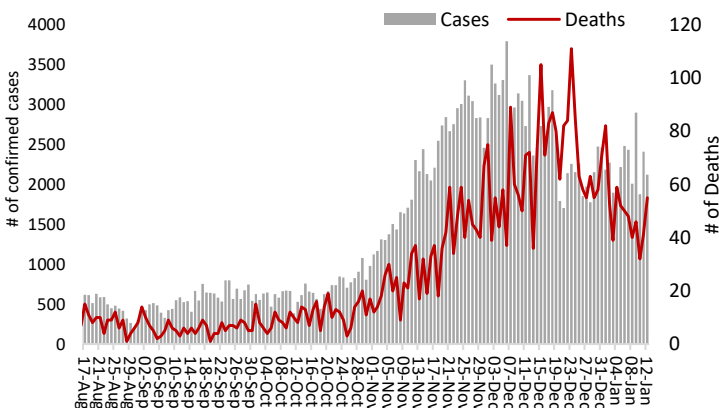

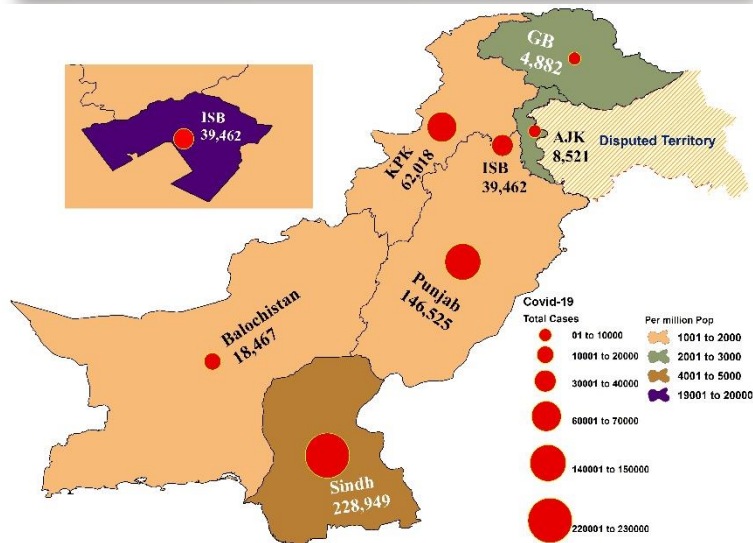


INCIDENCE & DEATHS BY DATE

17-Aug 2020 - 12-Jan 2021



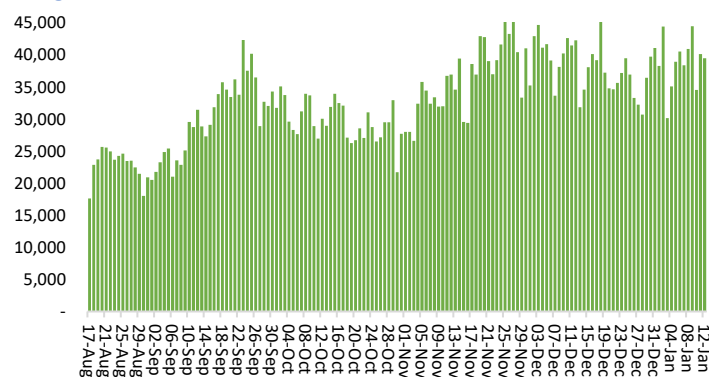
TOTAL CASES & CASES PER MILLION POP.



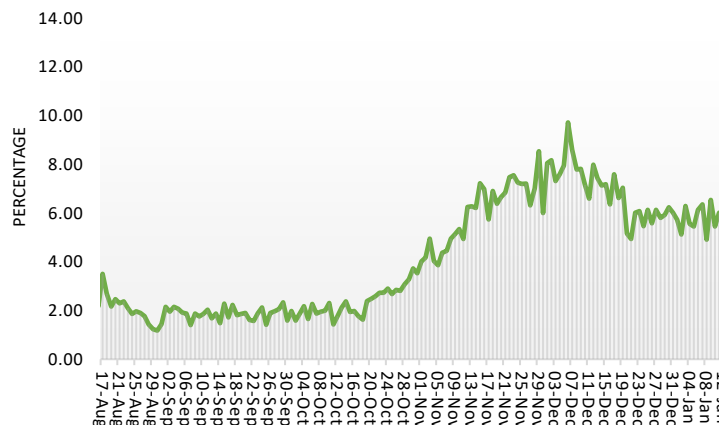
Pakistan reported **2,123** new cases of COVID-19 on **12 January 2021**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **508,824** with **10,772** deaths (**CFR: 2.12%**). Out of the total **33,102** currently active cases **2,850** cases are hospitalized.

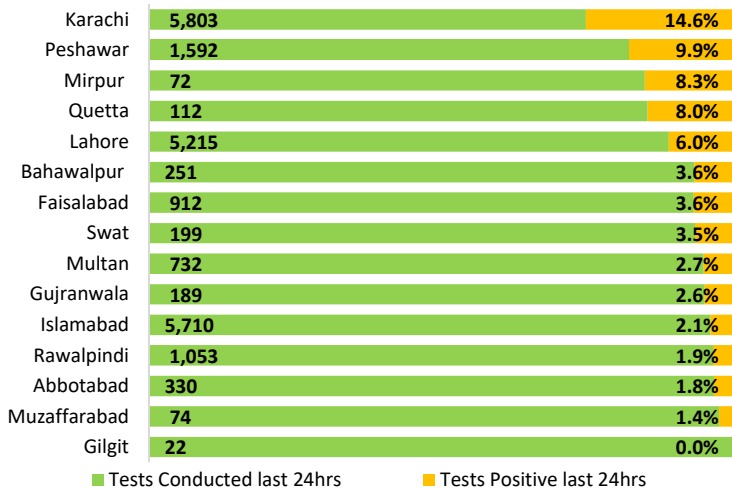
