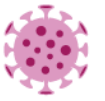

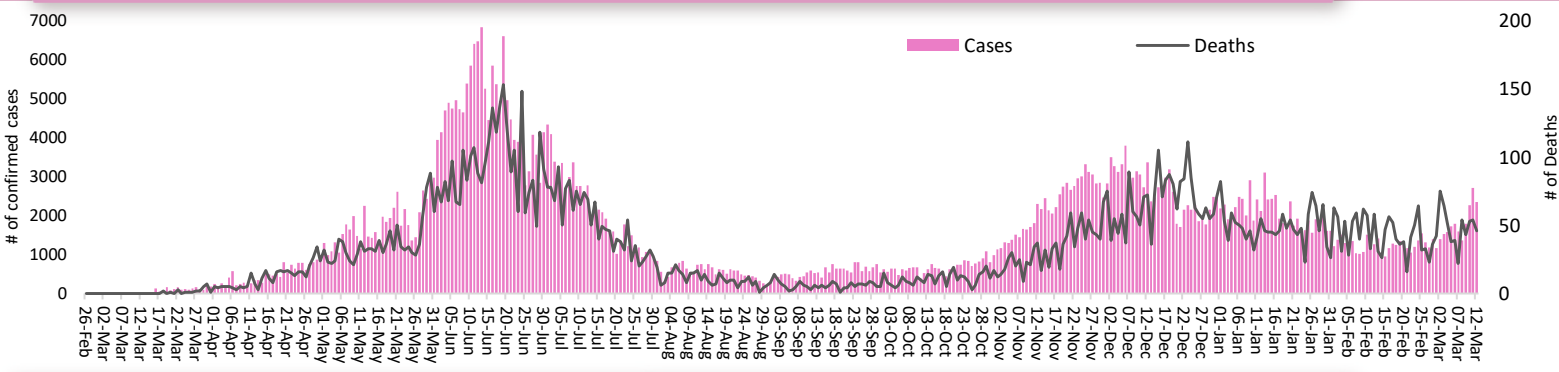

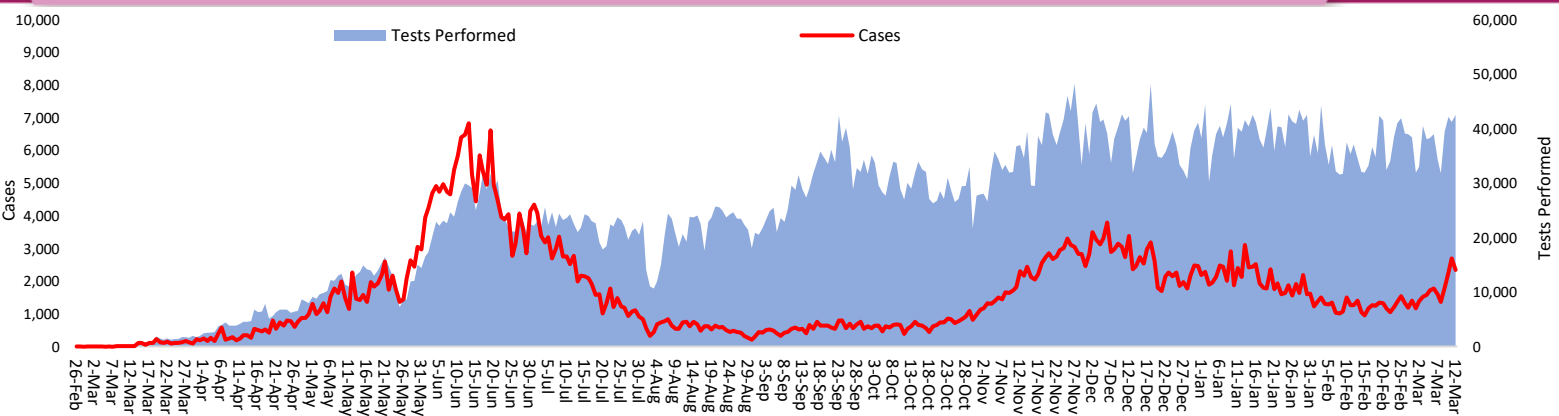

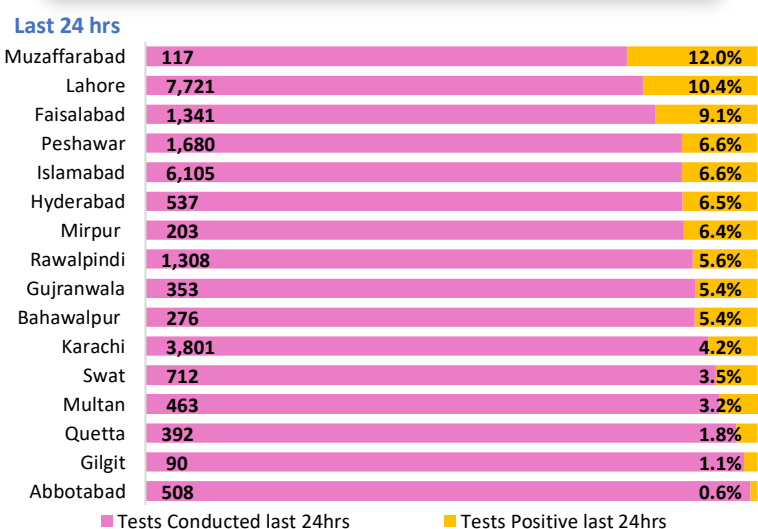
MEETING AND COORDINATION



World Health Organization Pakistan in collaboration with Field Epidemiology & Disease Surveillance Division, National Institute of Health Islamabad, and Provincial Health Department Balochistan conducted a three days training on Integrated Disease Surveillance and Response (IDSR) from 08-10 March 2021 in Pishin district. The objective of the training was to train health professionals of selected Health facilities on disease data collection, analysis utilization and reporting.

In the 1st batch 20 health professionals from 20 health facilities including 2 Rural Health Centers (RHCs) and 18 Basic Health Units (BHUs) from Pishin district attended the training. Dr Saeed Mirwani, DHO district Pishin, graced the opening session of the training. In his opening remarks he appreciated the WHO Pakistan support for implementation of IDSR in the selected districts of Balochistan province.
