

#### **MEETING AND COORDINATION**



On 13<sup>th</sup> April 2021, World Health Organization Pakistan in collaboration with Provincial Health Department Sindh, UNICEF and UNAIDS conducted a two days consultative meeting on HIV response in Larkana district. The purpose of the meeting was to review the existing trends in HIV testing services and develop a plan for enhancing HIV testing services at Rato Dero, Larkana.

In his speech, Dr Palitha lauded the Department of Health in responding to HIV Outbreak at Rato Dero, Larkana. He stressed the need for continuity of some evidence-based practices at community level, in addition to operational research on community IPC, mode of transmission, survival of HIV positive children and interruption of vertical transmission. He assured the Department of Health of full support from WHO to respond to HIV outbreak in Larkana. In his concluding remarks the Director General Health Services Sindh stressed on the need for establishing a mechanism for periodic analysis of data generated through delivery of HIV testing and treatment services, expedited support for socio-economic benefits to mothers through rehabilitation and enhancing multi-sectoral approach and coordination with safe blood transfusion, nutrition and others.
