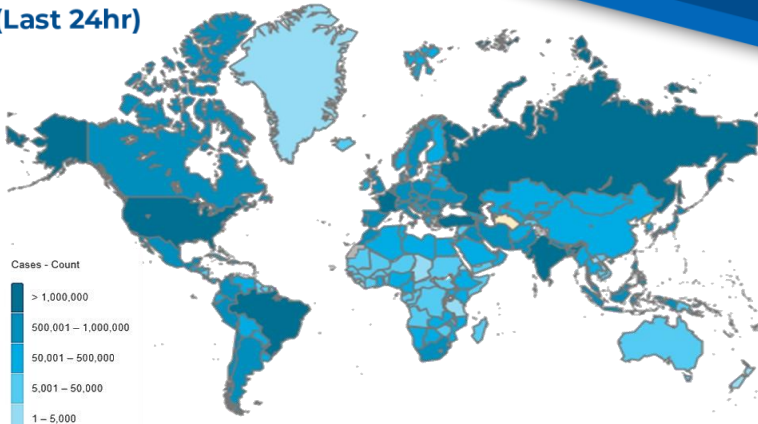

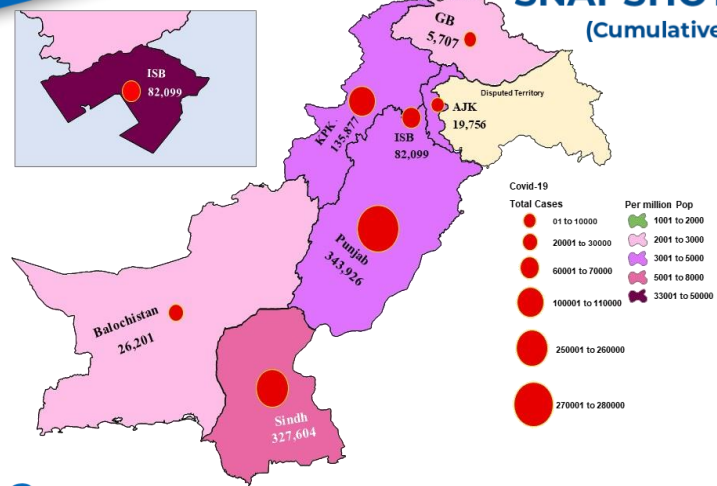

PAKISTAN COVID-19 SNAPSHOT (Cumulative)

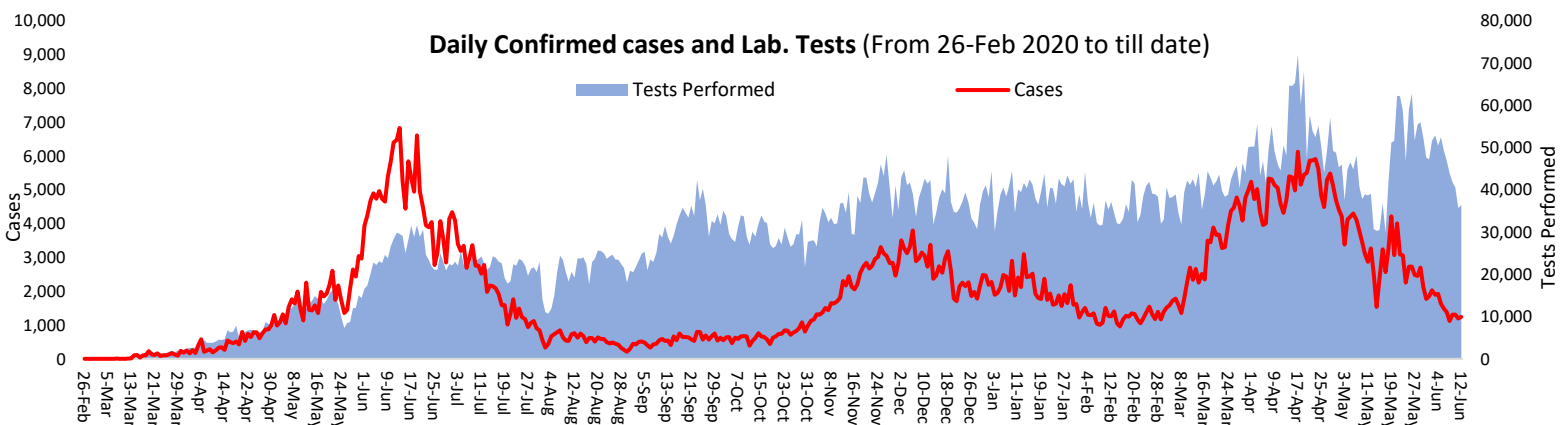
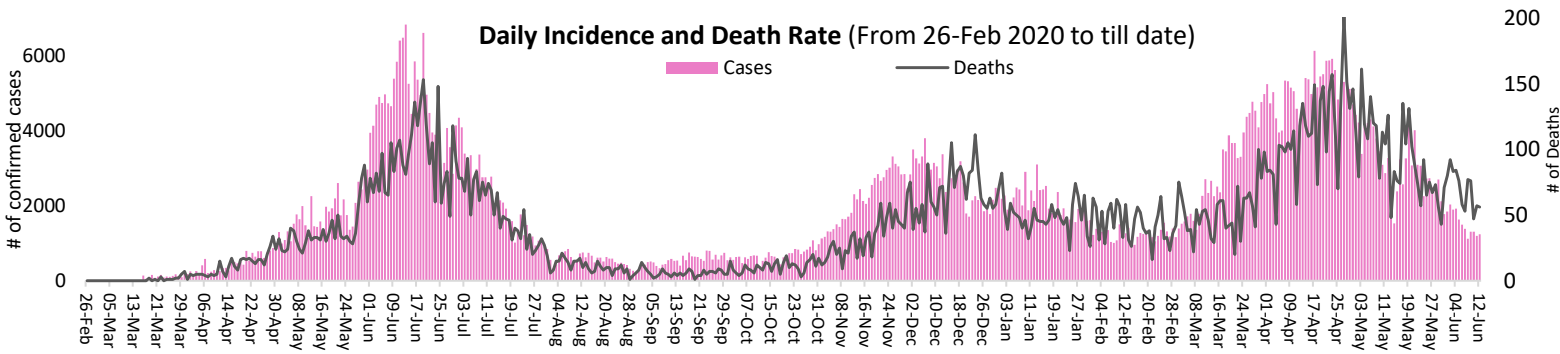

Meeting and Coordination

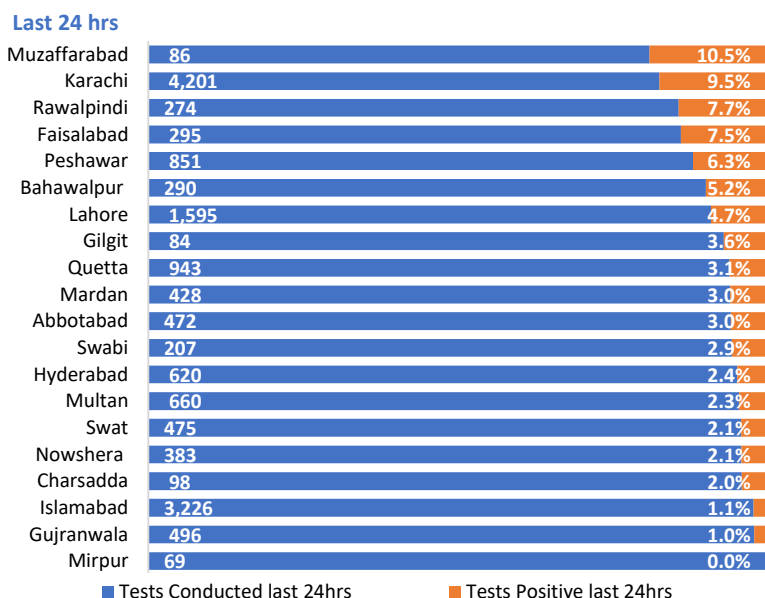


On 9th June 2021, WHO Regional Director (RD) for Eastern Mediterranean Region, Dr Ahmed Al-Mandhari and WHO Country Representative (WR) Pakistan, Dr Palitha Mahipala launched the Sindh Mobile Integrated Healthcare Services (SMIHS) in Karachi Division, Sindh Province. WHO Pakistan has donated six (06) mobile vans to SMIHS to support delivery of essential services such as immunization and nutrition programs.

As part of the launch, the RD and WR visited a mobile health camp set up at Zone B, Jhangabad Gana Mandi, East District at the invitation of the Project Director, EPI Sindh and participated in OPV vaccination exercise.

The project director EPI informed the RD and WR that through SMIHS an additional 13,000 children were immunised in the last 115 days.
