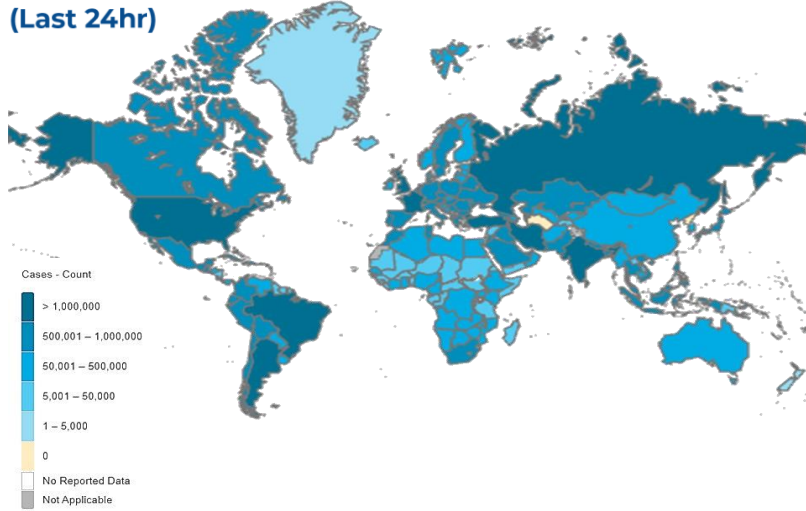
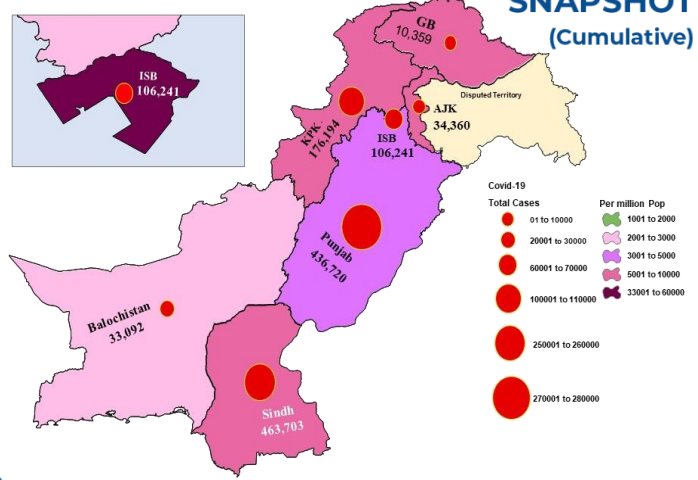

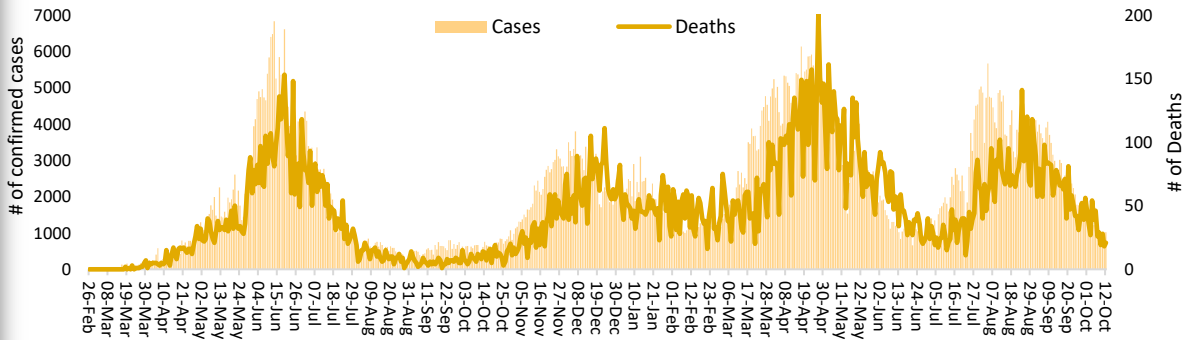

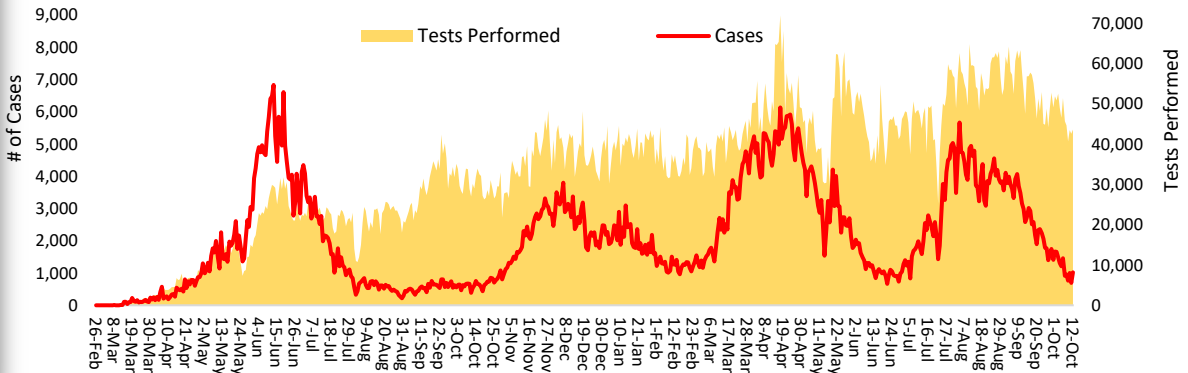

On 13th October 2021, WHO Country Representative Pakistan Dr Palitha Mahipala participated as the Chief guest in a seminar organized by the Institute of Psychiatry, Rawalpindi Medical University in collaboration with WHO. The ceremony was held at Rawalpindi Medical University. The theme of the day was “Mental Health in an Unequal World”

During his speech, Dr Palitha encouraged all stakeholders working on mental health issues to provide mental health education and advocacy to reduce stigma, discrimination, and human rights abuses of people with mental health conditions.

Prof. Asad Nizami, Head of Department of Psychiatry, acknowledged the leading role of WHO in mental health activities in Pakistan.
