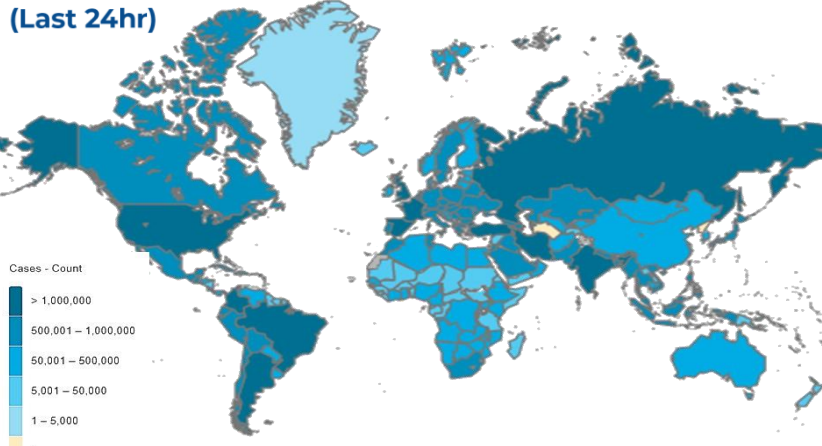




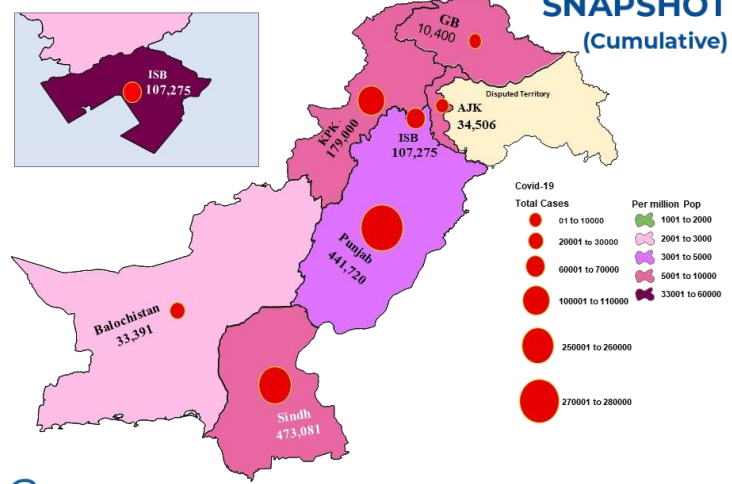

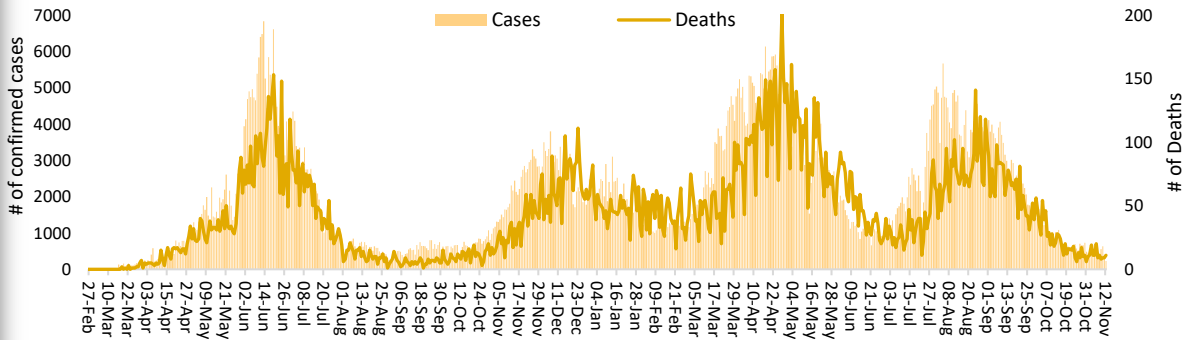

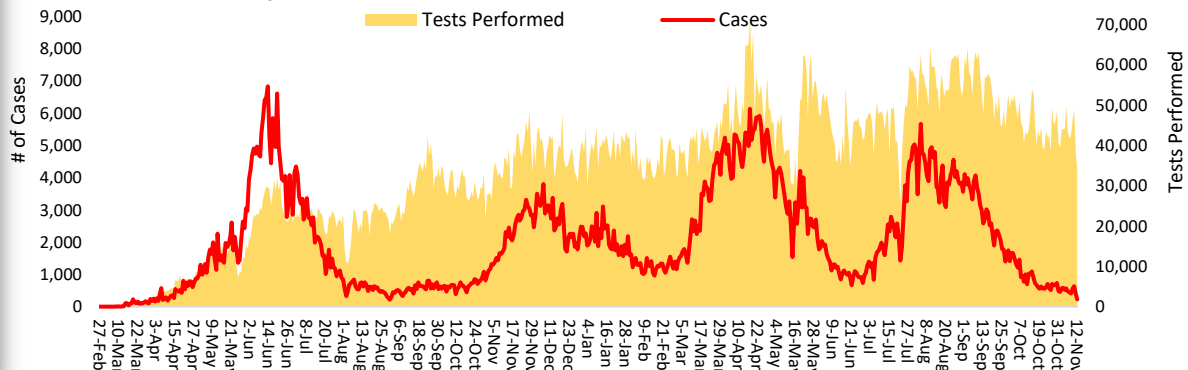

Daily Incidence and Death Rate (From 27 Feb 2020 to till date)



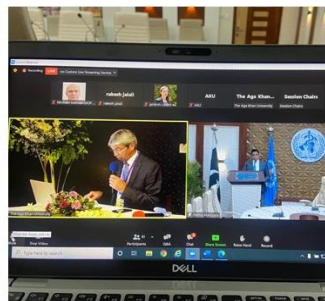
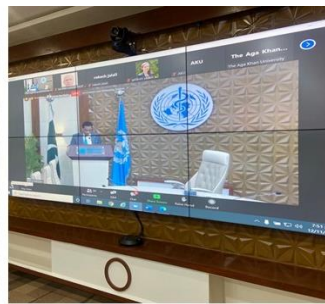
Daily Confirmed cases and Lab. Tests (From 27 Feb 2020 to till date)

On 11th November 2021, WHO Country Representative Pakistan, Dr Palitha Mahipala participated in the inaugural session of the second Pakistan Pediatric Neuro-Oncology Symposium (2PNOS) that was held at the Aga Khan University, Karachi from 12th -13th November 2021. The conference was held under the theme “Capacity Building of Pediatric Neuro-Oncology in Low and Middle-Income Countries” (LMIC). Participants and facilitators for the conference were drawn from international universities and organizations.

In his remarks, Dr Palitha thanked the scientific and organizing committee members who worked hard to put together the program. He emphasized on the need to invest in building the technical capacity and infrastructure needed to improve Pediatric Neuro Oncology services in Pakistan.
