





INCIDENCE & DEATHS BY DATE




TOTAL CASES & CASES PER MILLION POP.




Pakistan reported **3,369** new cases of COVID-19 on **12 December 2020**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **438,425** with **8,796** deaths **(CFR: 2.00%)**. Out of the total **46,629** currently active cases **3,011** cases are hospitalized.

MEETINGS & COORDINATION

The WHO country office Pakistan in collaboration with the Nutrition section, Ministry of National Health Services Regulation & Coordination (MoNHSR&C), Government of Pakistan conducted a three days Training of Trainers (ToT) on Managing Lactation and Baby Friendly Hospital Initiative (BFHI). The training was conducted at Pakistan Air Force (PAF) Hospital, Islamabad. The training session was opened on 10 December by Dr. Baseer Khan Achakzai, Director, Nutrition section, MoNHSR&C. While presiding over the opening session, The Director Nutrition MNHSR&C highlighted the vision of the Government of Pakistan toward the effective implementation of BFHI.
