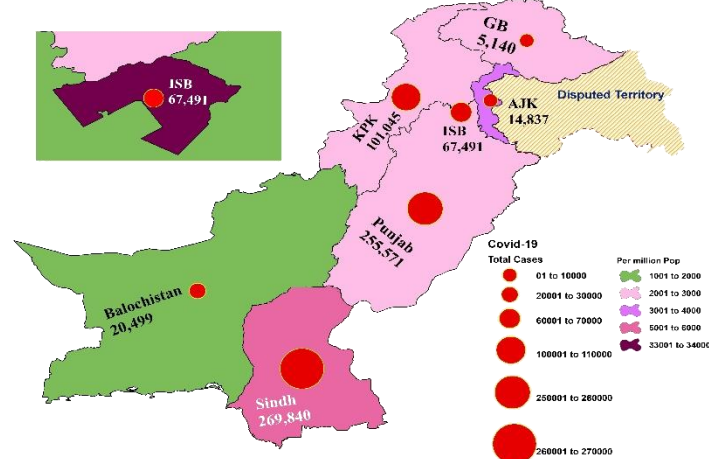
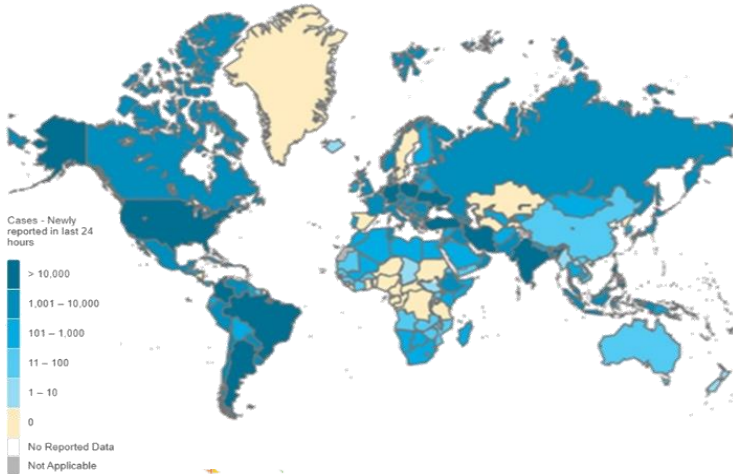

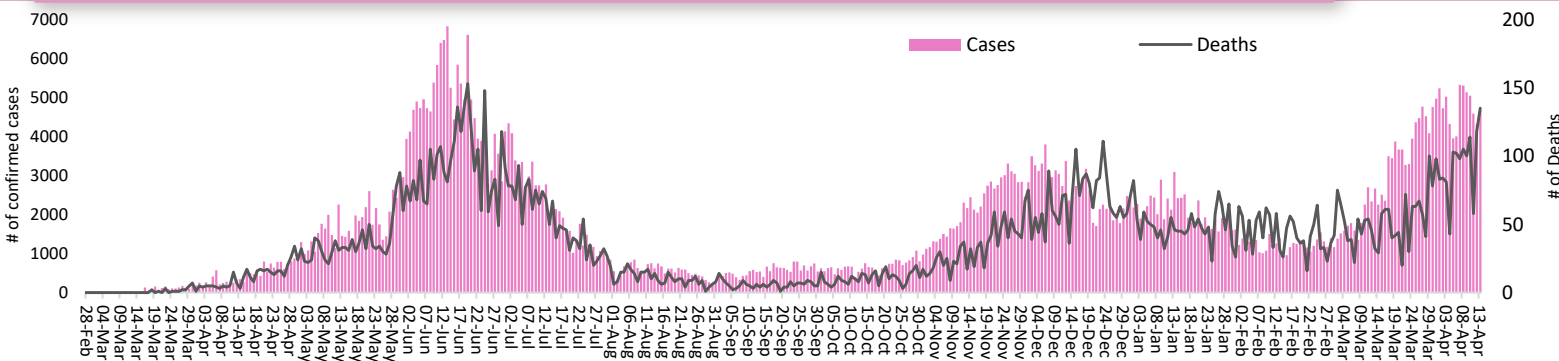
PAKISTAN COVID-19 SNAPSHOT (Cumulative)



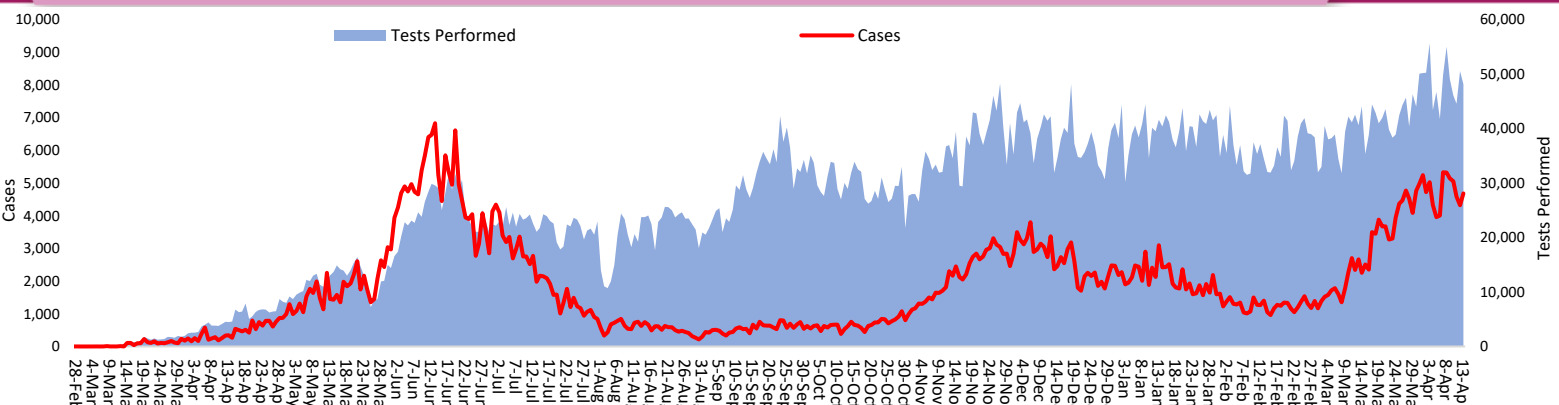

MEETING AND COORDINATION

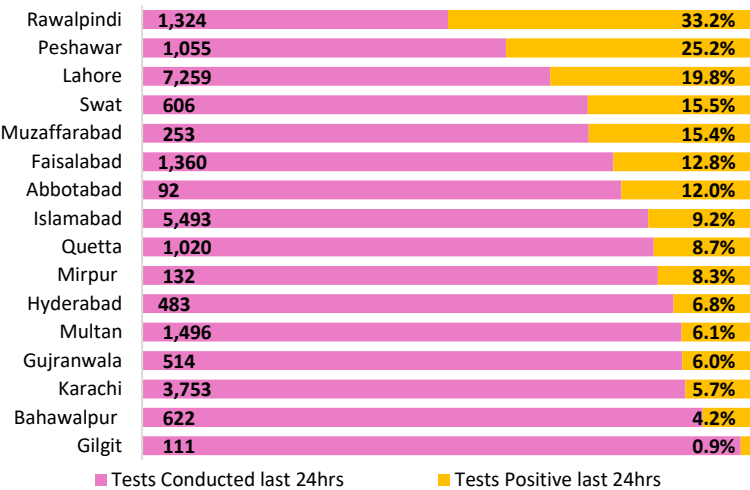


On 13th April 2021, WHO Country Representative Pakistan Dr Palitha Mahipala met with the vice chancellor, Shaheed Mohtarma Benazir Bhutto Medical University, Larkana Prof. Dr Aneela Ur Rehman. The purpose of the meeting was to discuss future collaboration between WHO and the university. The key discussion point was the roll out of a certification course for doctors and nurses on infection prevention and control and research in communicable diseases (HIV and other public health) through their community health department. The WR also discussed the need to include IPC in the curriculum of undergraduate students.

Dr. Aneela acknowledged the support of WHO Pakistan for the implementation of Early Essential Newborn Care (EENC) and implementation of Infection Control & Prevention (IPC) in district Larkana, Sindh.
