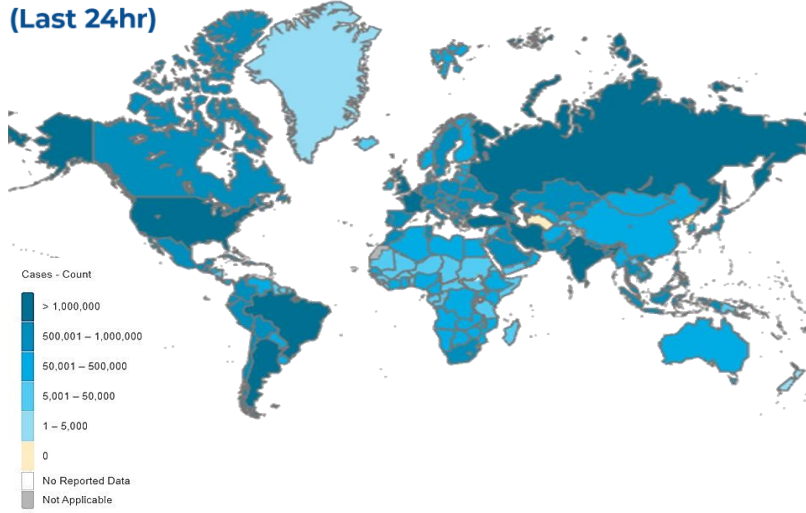
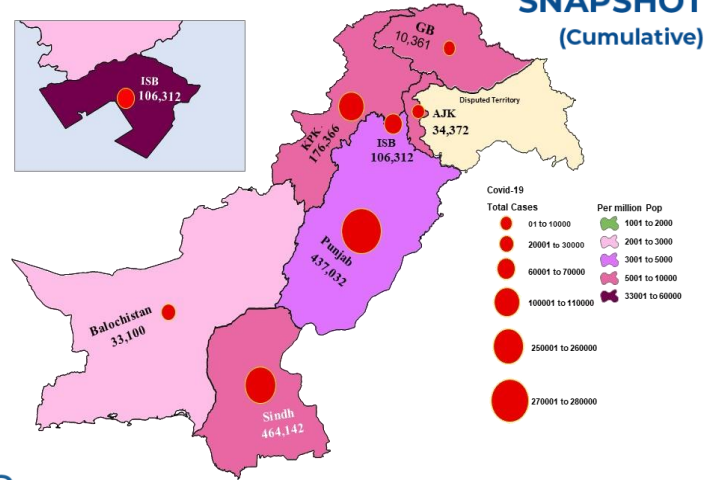

PAKISTAN COVID-19 SNAPSHOT (Cumulative)



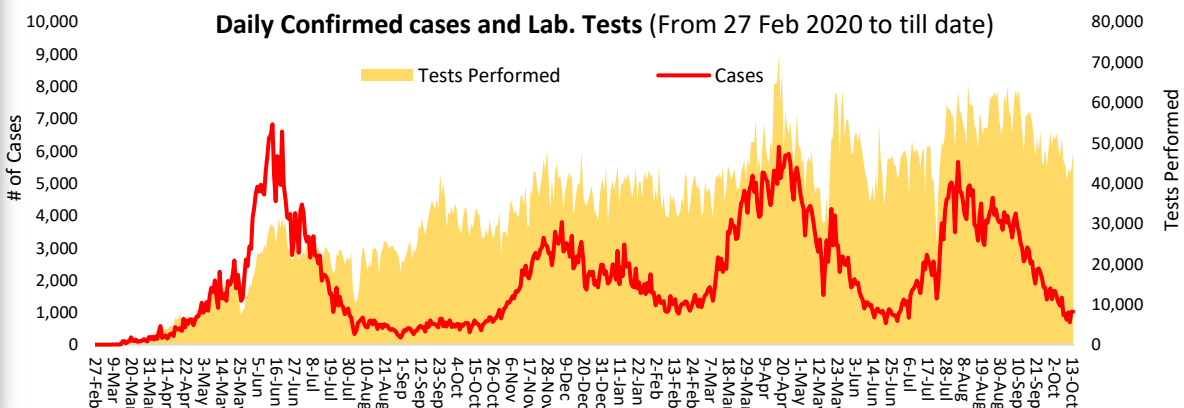
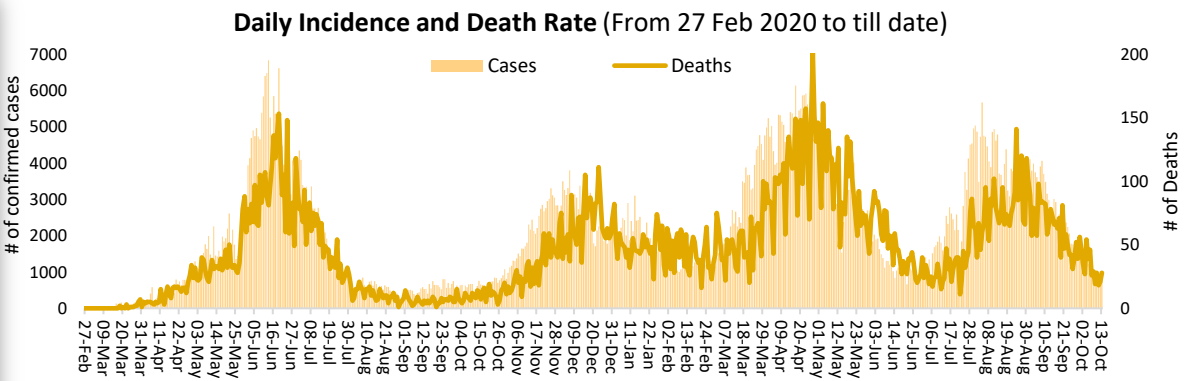

On 8th October 2021, the MONHSR&C and WHO conducted advocacy for Breast cancer. The awareness campaign was launched by the President of Pakistan H.E Dr Arif Alvi and First Lady Samina Alvi at Presidents house, Islamabad. Among the key dignitaries in attendance were the Special Assistant to PM on Health Dr. Faisal Sultan and WHO Country Representative Pakistan Dr Palitha Mahipala.

In his remarks, Dr Palitha emphasized on the need to educate the community on breast cancer risks factors, breast-self-examination for early detection and diagnosis, treatment, and reconstruction services. He also appreciated the Government of Pakistan for the COVID-19 response. The First Lady informed the audience of increasing awareness on breast cancer and commended WHO for capacity building of the lady health workers in breast self-examination. The President applauded the media for its role in enhancing breast cancer awareness.
