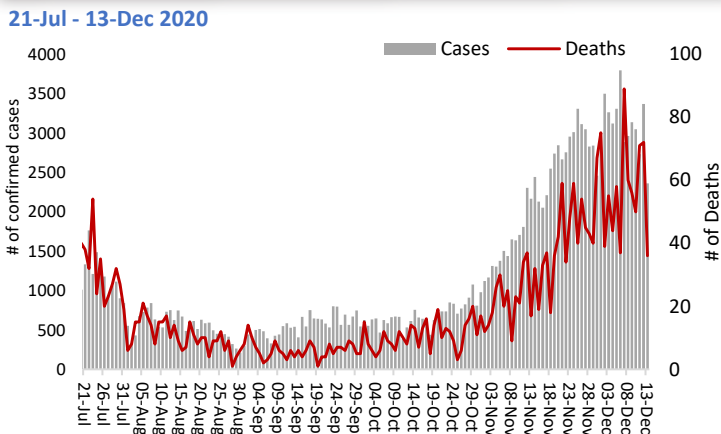

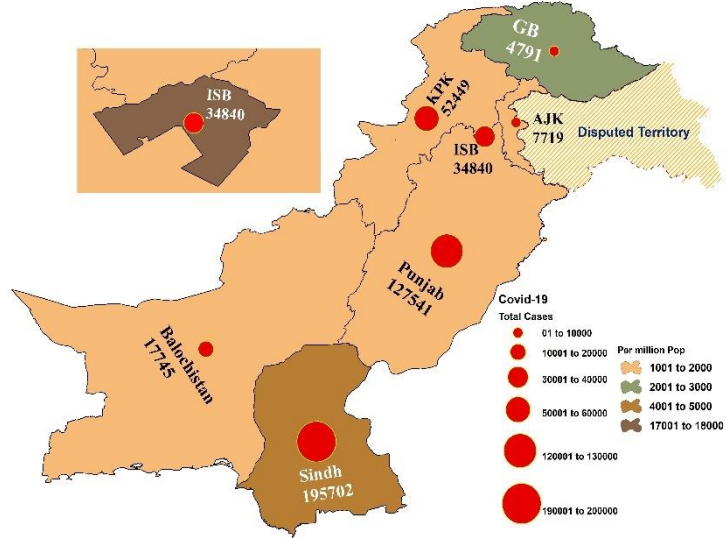

INCIDENCE & DEATHS BY DATE

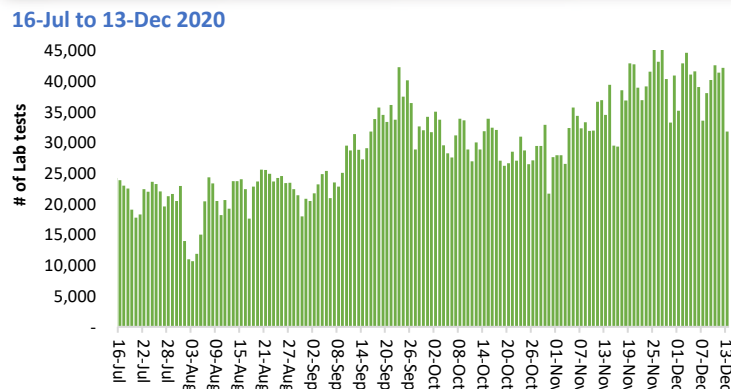


TOTAL CASES & CASES PER MILLION POP.

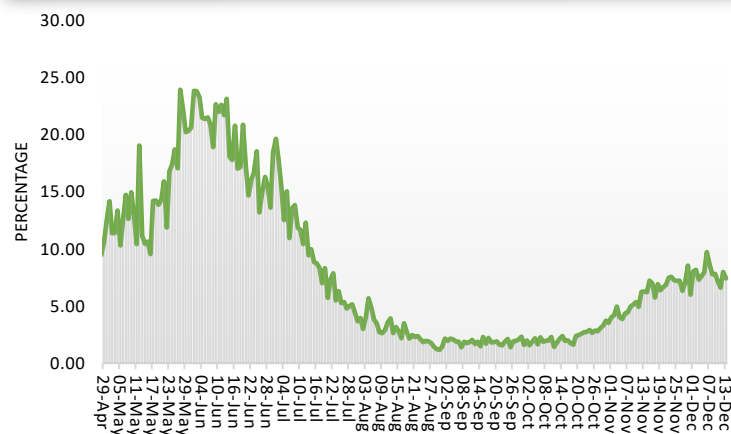


Pakistan reported **2,362** new cases of COVID-19 on **13 December 2020**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **440,787** with **8,832** deaths (**CFR: 2.00%**). Out of the total **47,236** currently active cases **3,014** cases are hospitalized.
