







INCIDENCE & DEATHS BY DATE




TOTAL CASES & CASES PER MILLION POP.




Pakistan reported 1,048 new cases of COVID-19 on 14th February 2021. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is 564,077 with 12,333 deaths (CFR: 2.19%). Out of the total 25,747 currently active cases 2,115 cases are hospitalized.

SUMMARY TABLE BY PROVINCE

MEETINGS & COORDINATION

On 12th February 2021, World Health Organization Pakistan in collaboration with the Provincial health department Sindh conducted orientation session on SARI/ILI sentinel surveillance for the District Health Management Team in Hyderabad division. Director General Health Sindh, Dr Irshad Ahmad Memon and Head of WHO sub-office Sindh, Dr Sara Salman, Co-chaired the meeting. The objective of the meeting was to advocate for strengthening the SARI/ILI sentinel surveillance and implementation of IDSR.

All District Health Officers (DHOs) and district Focal Persons for the COVID-19, SARI/ILI Sentinel surveillance from the 9 districts and 3 PEI District Surveillance Officers of the Hyderabad Division attended the meeting. The current gaps in SARI / ILI cases detection and referral for lab testing in the districts and the way forward was reviewed with the DHOs. Dr Irshad Ahmed DG Health Sindh directed all the DHOs to focus on the data quality, strengthening of SARI/ILI sentinel sites surveillance and ensure all the sentinel site focal persons are notified in all the districts.
