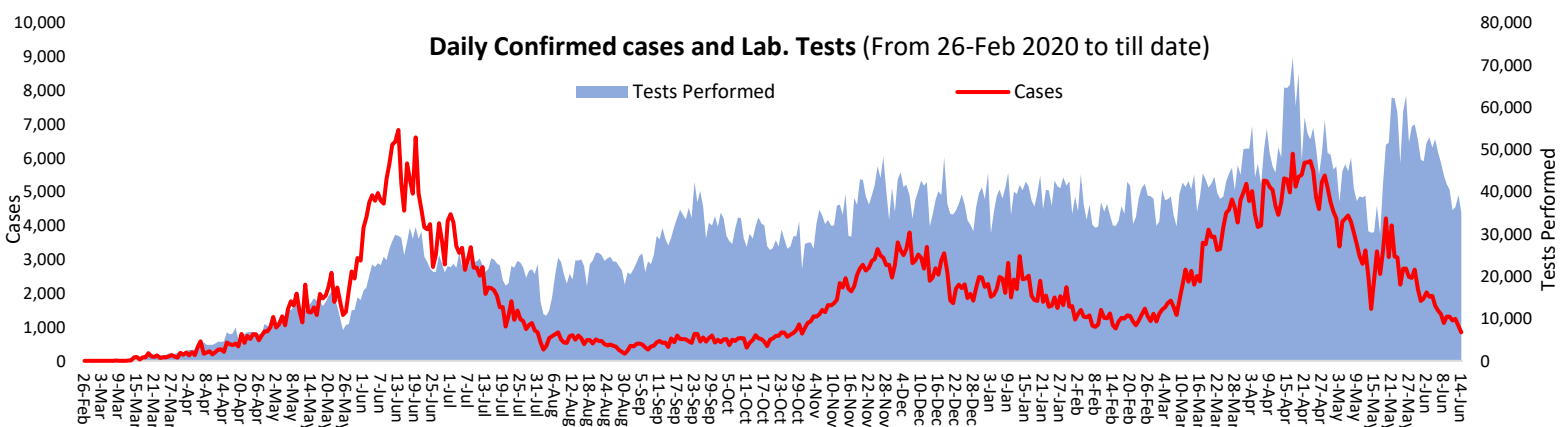

Meeting and Coordination

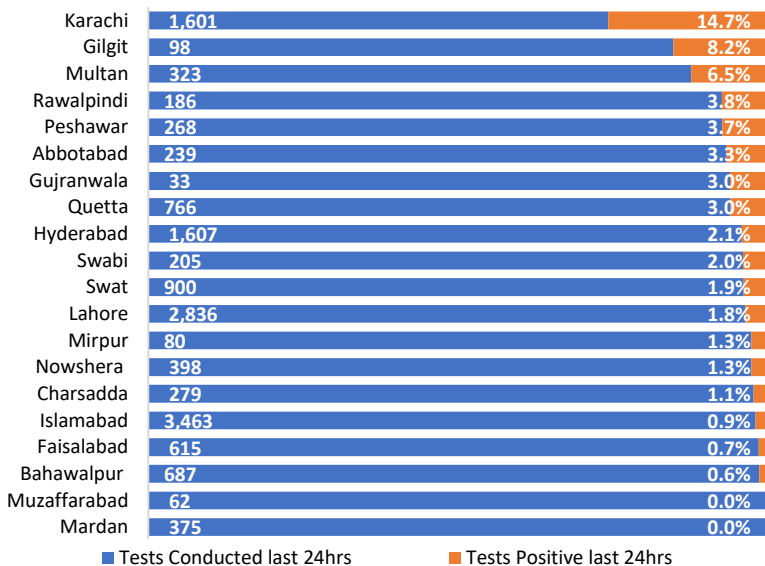
