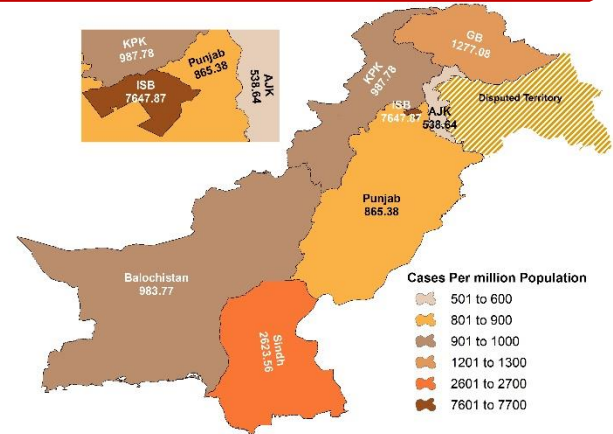

### COVID-19 case density/million Population

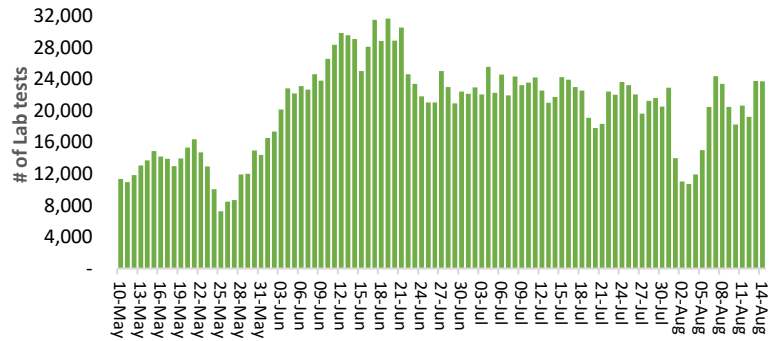


### Executive Summary

Pakistan reported **747** new cases of COVID-19 on **14 August 2020**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **288,047** with **6,162** deaths (CFR: **2.13%**). Out of the total **16,261** currently active cases, **1,311** cases are hospitalized, out of which **768 (58.58%)** are in critical condition. **14,950** COVID-19 positive cases are at designated isolation facilities or in-home isolation. A total of **265,624 (92.21%)** have recovered and discharged.

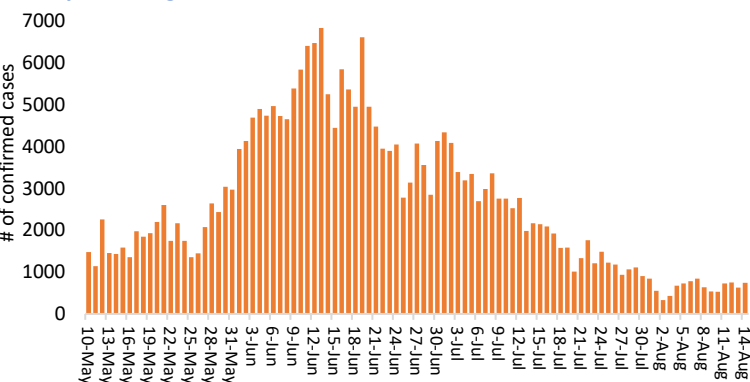
### Daily Lab tests conducted in Pakistan

10 May to 14 Aug 2020



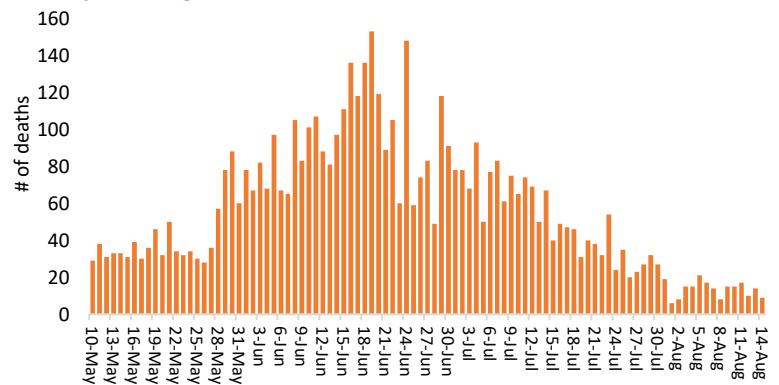
### Daily incidence of COVID-19 cases in Pakistan

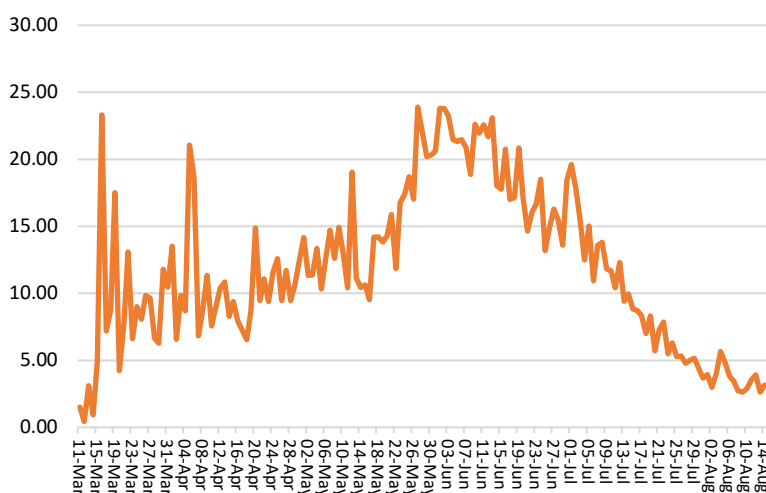


## Coordination & Meetings

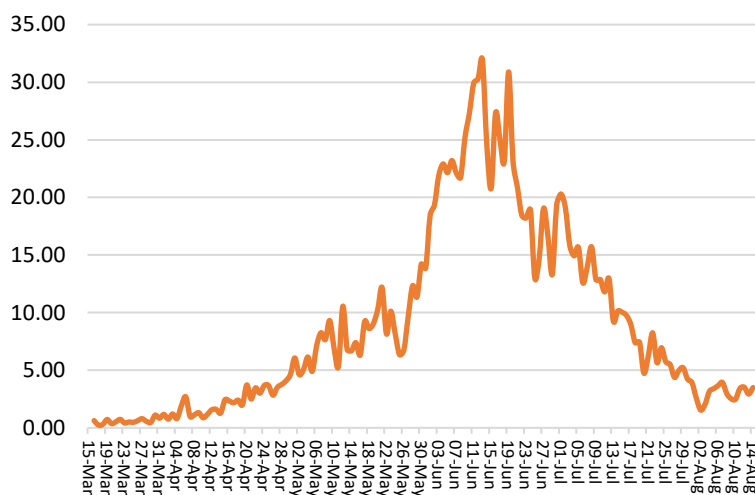
Today, 15<sup>th</sup> August 2020, The WHO Country Representative, Pakistan Dr Palitha Mahipala, visited district Swabi, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Province to monitor Polio Campaign.

During the visit, The WR met the District Health Officer, Dr Kaleem Khan Khuttak and was briefed about the polio campaign. In response the WR discussed the issue of maintaining SOPs for COVID-19 for POLIO health workers and applauded the effort of the district in controlling the outbreak of COVID-19.

## Maintaining Essential Health Services in Pakistan

Government of Sindh with support from partner organization launched polio campaign across Sindh Province. The campaign is scheduled to start today 15<sup>th</sup> through to 21<sup>st</sup> August 2020. A total of 9.2 million children will be targeted during this campaign. 23,906 teams will be deployed during this campaign.

In addition, the EPI team is conducting an Environmental Social Management Planning (ESMP), Assessment in four districts (Larkana, Khairpur, Badin and West Karachi) in Sindh province. 31 indicators will be assessed in the following key areas; waste management, logistic management, program management and vaccine stockout.

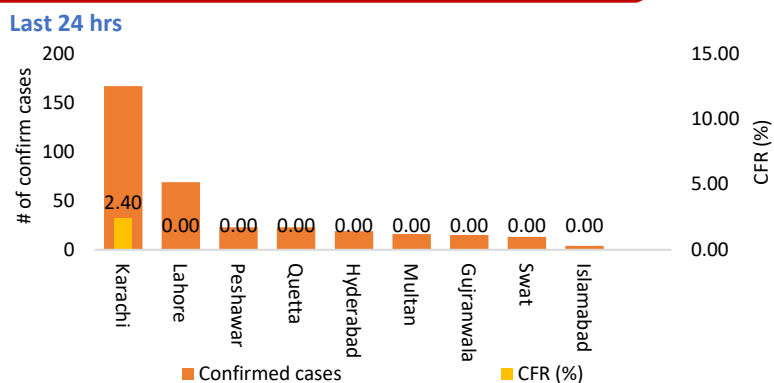


ESMP assessment being conducted at KMC dispensary Bijli Nagar, UC Mominbad, Orangi Town.

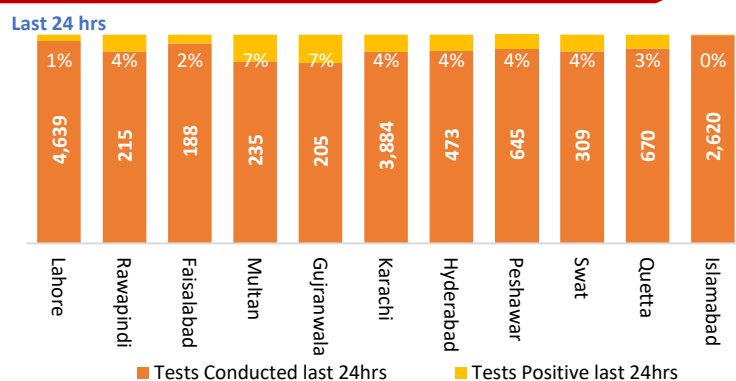

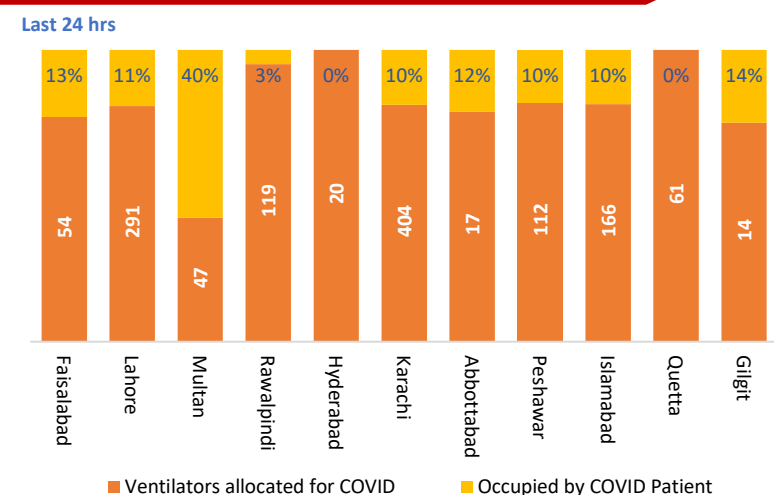
## COVID-19 confirmed cases & CFR (%) by districts
