

Executive Summary

Pakistan reported 404 new cases of COVID-19 on 14 September 2020. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is 302,424 with 6,389 deaths (CFR: 2.11%). Out of the total 5,774 currently active cases, 1,009 cases are hospitalized, out of which **563 (55.79%)** are in critical condition. **4,765** COVID-19 positive cases are at designated isolation facilities or inhome isolation. A total of 290,261 (95.97%) have recovered and discharged.





Daily Incidence by Province








Daily COVID-19 Positivity Rate




The objective of the training is continuity of sexual, reproductive and maternal health services with respect to COVID-19. Over fifteen health professionals were trained.

Daily COVID-19 Attack rate Per million population




COVID-19 Confirmed cases & CFR

by Major Cities / Districts




Occupied COVID-19 ventilators
