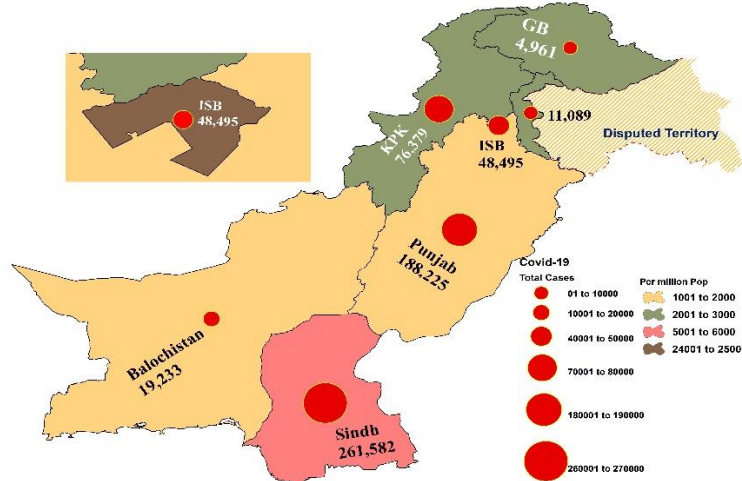
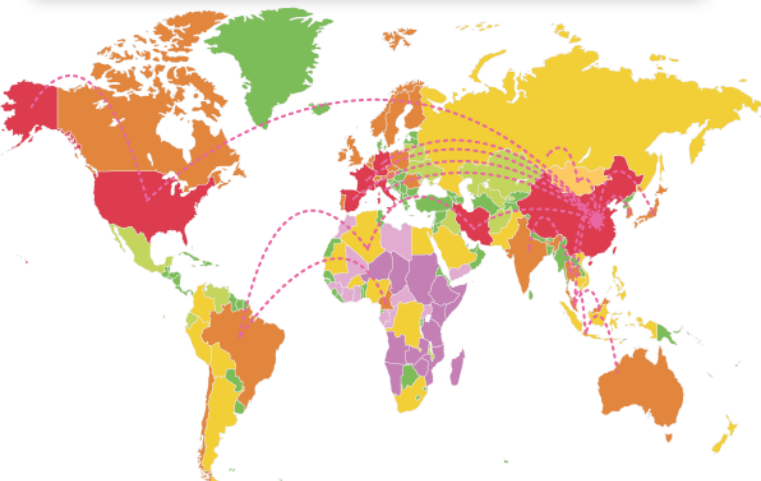

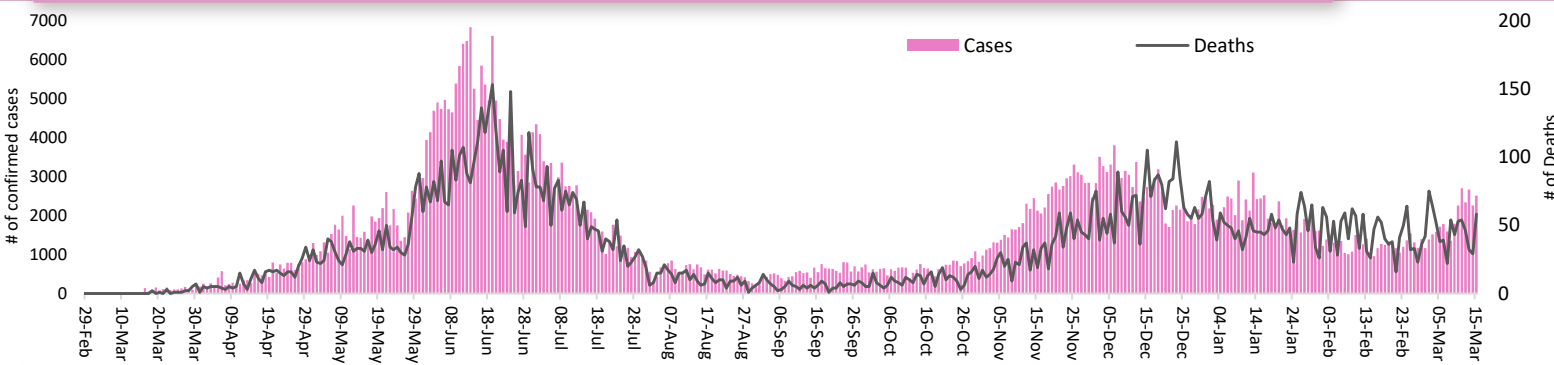

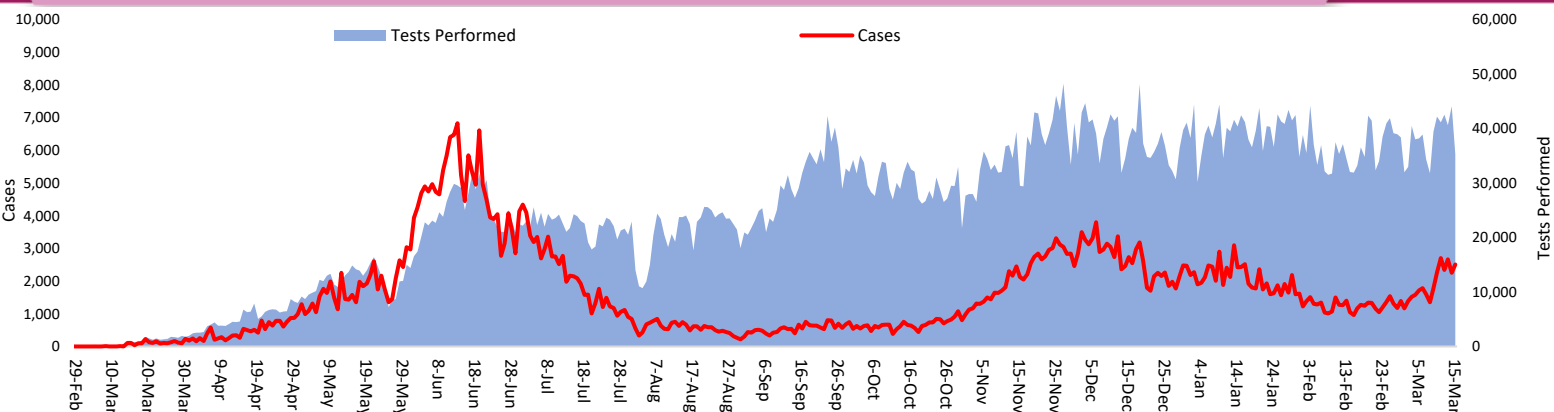

MEETING AND COORDINATION

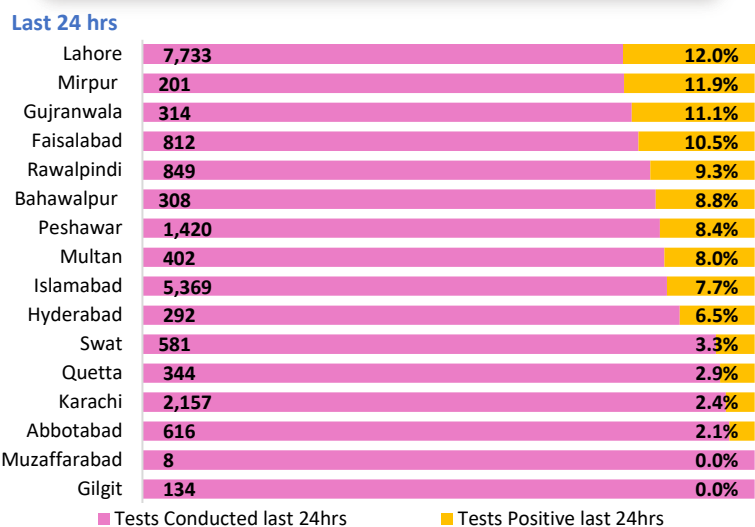
On 15th March 2021, WHO Country Representative, Pakistan Dr Palitha Mahipala, handed over CTL ImmunoSpot S6 MACRO Analyzer which is an essential equipment required for the cell-based analysis, to the Executive Director, National Institute of Health, Islamabad Maj. Gen. Aamer Ikram.

Currently, with support from the WHO EMRO and HQ, WHO Pakistan is collaborating with the National Institute of Health Islamabad in Implementation of the first study on T-cell based response to the SARS-CoV-2 infections among the health care workers.

The study will provide valuable insights on the cellular response to SARS-CoV2 infections among the health care workers which is an identified high-risk group.
