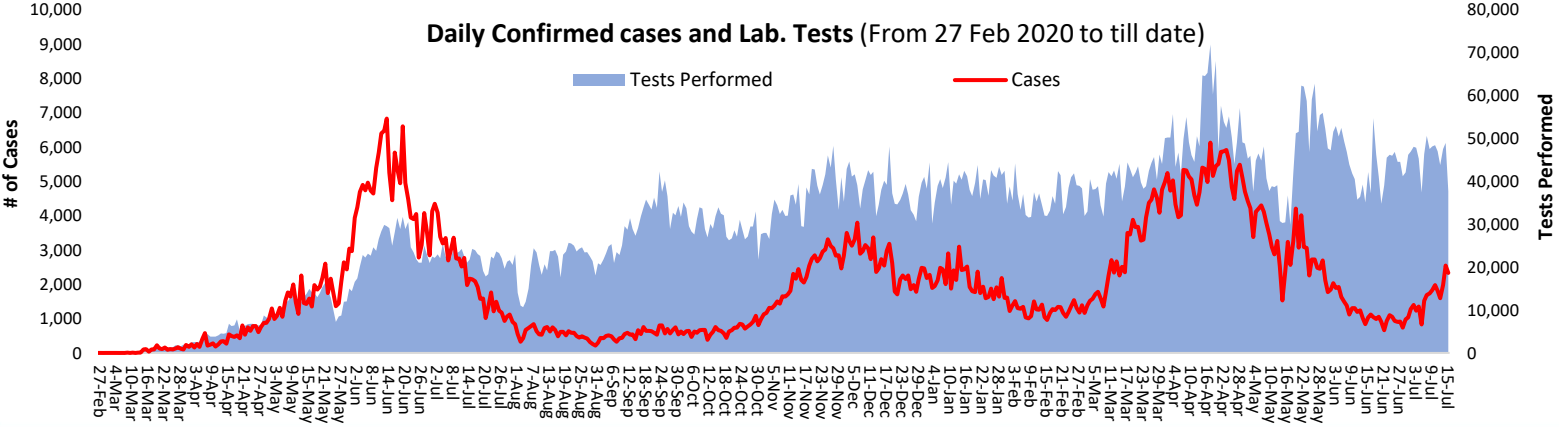

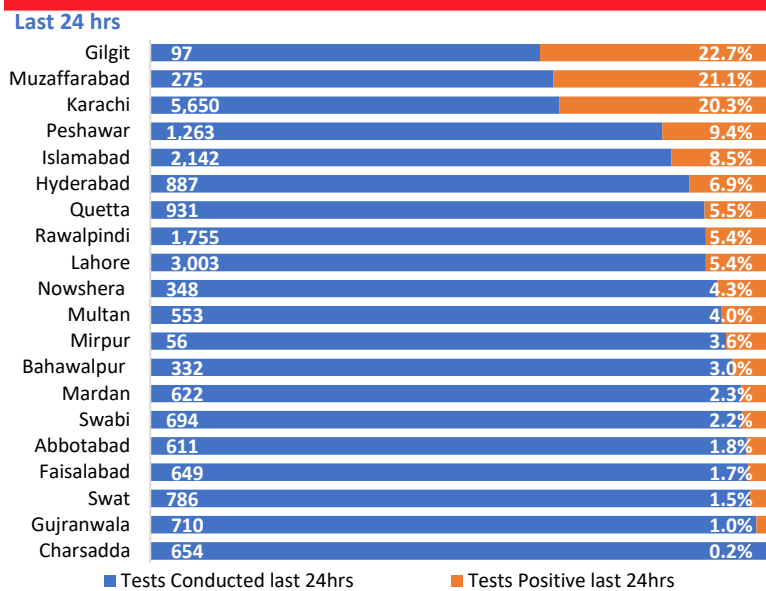

Meeting and Coordination



On 14 July 2021, WHO Country Representative Pakistan, Dr Palitha Mahipala visited Allama Iqbal International Airport Lahore. The purpose of the visit was to provide technical support to the implementation of COVID-19 surveillance at points of entry, in view of the spread of SARS COV2 variants. During his visit, the WR handed over donation of 5000, COVID-19 Rapid Antigen Testing Kits, Masks and hand sanitizers to the In-charge Airport Health Authority, Dr Amena Saqib. In attendance was Airport Health Officer, Dr Shahzad Naseem. In his remarks, Dr Palitha emphasized on the importance of increase COVID-19 preventive messages at points of entry and, pledged WHO support for this purpose. The Airport Health Officer, Dr Shahzad expressed his appreciation on behalf of Central Health Establishment. He stated that the donation will go a long way in bolstering the surveillance activities at the airport, particularly screening and infection prevention and control.

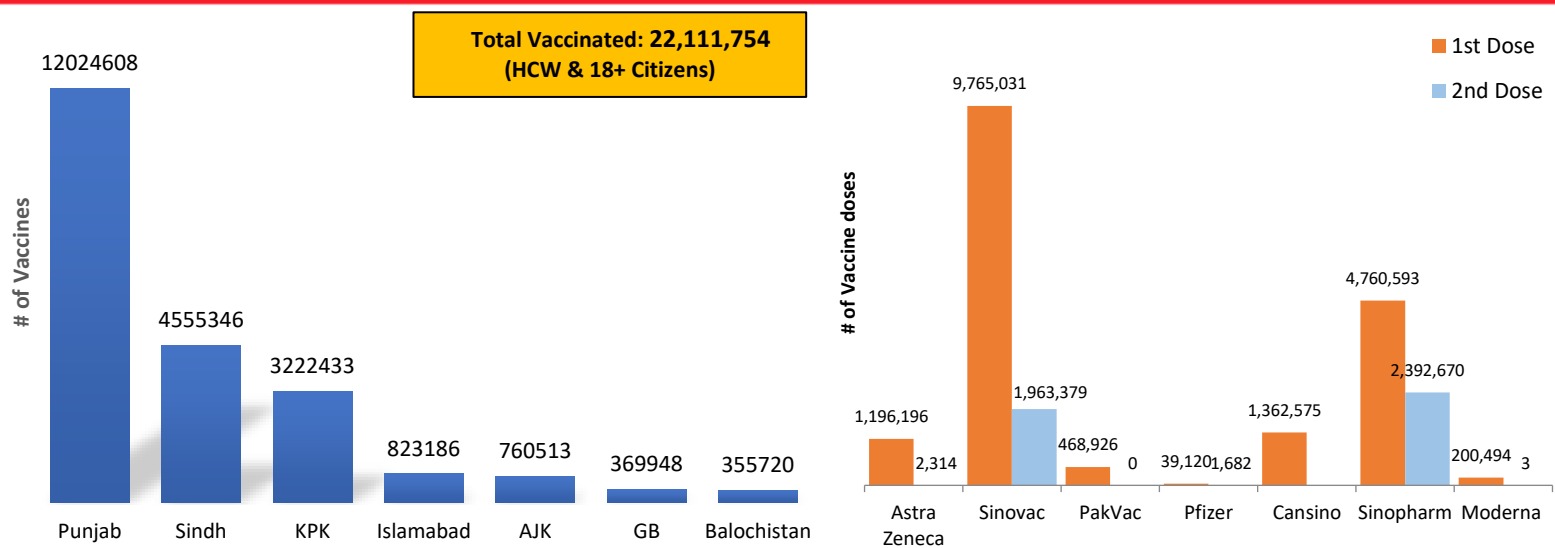
