

### **Executive Summary**


Pakistan reported **665** new cases of COVID-19 on **15 September 2020**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **303,089** with **6,393** deaths **(CFR: 2.11%)**. Out of the total **5,936** currently active cases, **995** cases are hospitalized, out of which **571 (57.38%)** are in critical condition. **4,941** COVID-19 positive cases are at designated isolation facilities or in-home isolation. A total of **290,760 (95.93%)** have recovered and discharged.

## **Daily Incidence/Mortality**





#### **Daily Incidence by Province**





#### **Daily COVID-19 Positivity Rate**




#### **Maintaining Essential Health Services**



# Trends of COVID-19 confirmed cases








# COVID-19 Confirmed cases & CFR

#### by Major Cities / Districts




#### **Occupied COVID-19 ventilators**
