





INCIDENCE & DEATHS BY DATE




TOTAL CASES & CASES PER MILLION POP.



Pakistan reported 2,521 new cases of COVID-19 on 16 January 2021. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is 519,291 with 10,951 deaths (CFR: 2.11%). Out of the total 34,701 currently active cases 2,876 cases are hospitalized.

MEETINGS & COORDINATION

On 16th January 2021, WHO Country Representative Pakistan Dr Palitha Mahipala met with the newly elected Mayor of Islamabad HE Peer Adil Shah Gillani in his office. The meeting was also attended by the Director General Health Services Metropolitan Corporation Islamabad (MCI), Dr Hassan Orooj. The three discussed among others, the Islamabad Health Equity model which aims at implementing Public health measures equally in all areas of Islamabad, the Healthy City program that will be launched in February 2021 and joint implementation of COVID-19 awareness raising campaign.

HE the Mayor appreciated WHO for the continuous support to Polio Eradication, responding to outbreak of Dengue in Islamabad and supporting the ongoing outbreak of COVID-19. Dr Palitha assured HE the Mayor of continuing WHO support to MCI.
