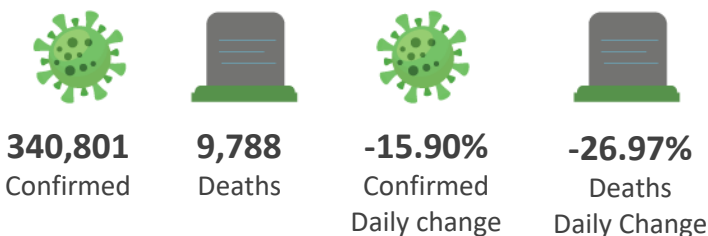


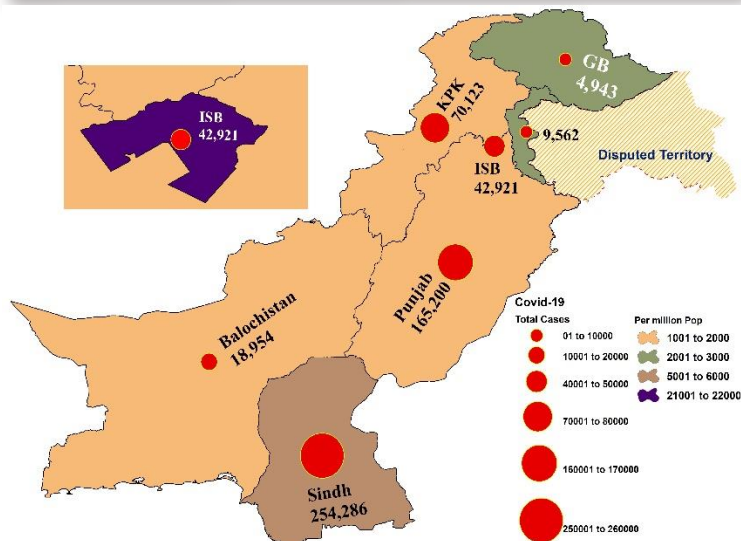

GLOBAL UPDATES (as of 15th February 2021)

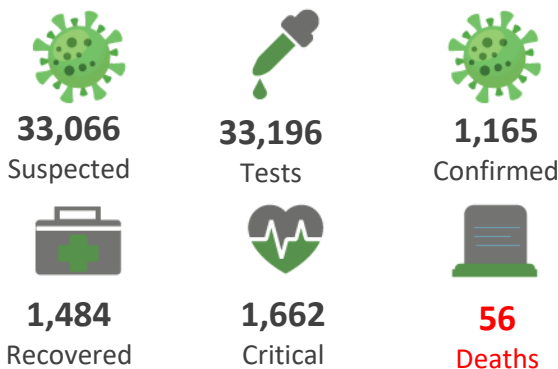


TOTAL CASES & CASES PER MILLION POP.



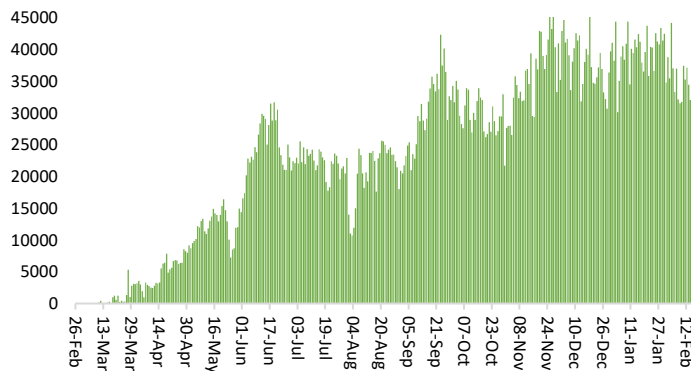
Pakistan reported **1,165** new cases of COVID-19 on **16th February 2021**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **565,989** with **12,436** deaths (CFR: **2.20%**). Out of the total **25,008** currently active cases **2,113** cases are hospitalized.

PAKISTAN UPDATES (Last 24hr)



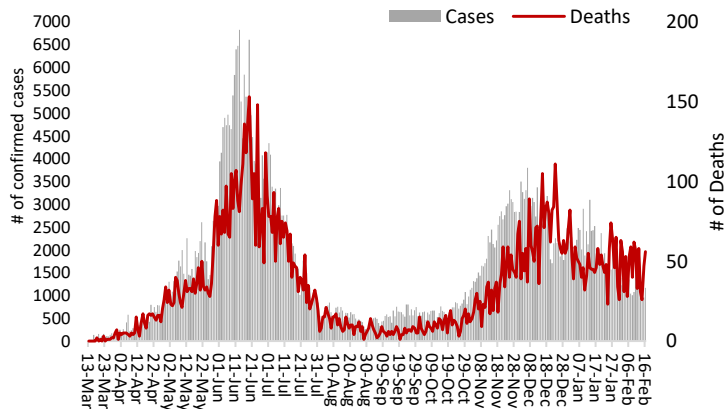
LAB TEST (PCR + RA) CONDUCTED BY DATE

26-Feb 2020 - 16-Feb 2021

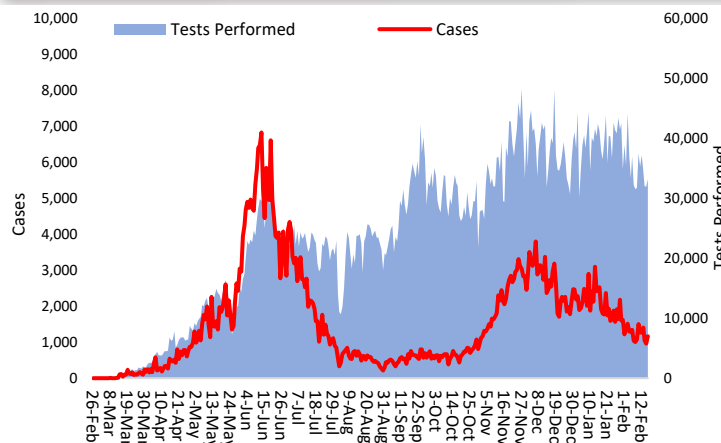


INCIDENCE & DEATHS BY DATE

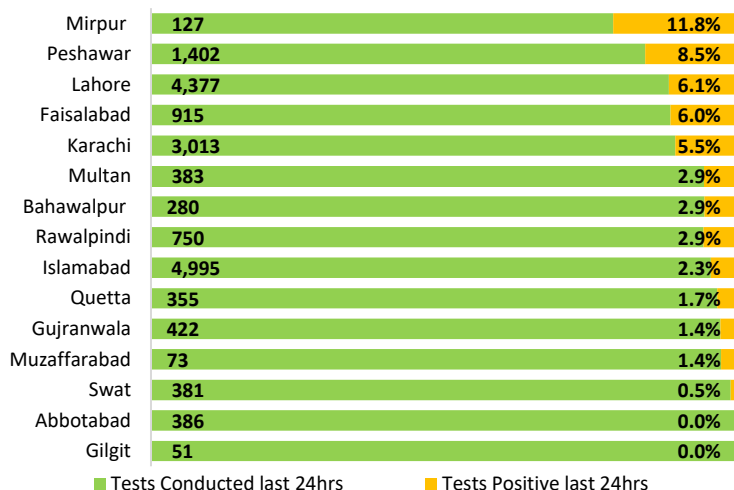

MEETINGS & COORDINATION

On 12th February 2021, Head of WHO Sub Office Punjab, Dr. Jamshaid Ahmed along with Dr Yahya Gulzar (NPO) and Dr Shaukat Ali (DO-EPI) met with the Secretary Health South Punjab, Mohammad Ajmal Bhatti at south Punjab secretariat Multan. The objective of the meeting was to discuss plan for the Infection Prevention & Control (IPC) training at South Punjab hospitals. The training is in response to the Secretary's request to WR for WHO support for the training. During the meeting all aspects of the training, including technical sessions, participants eligibility criteria, course modalities, implementation, and monitoring were discussed. The secretary also proposed to plan one-day orientation session and a visit to the IPC demonstration sites for the Medical Superintendents of the selected hospitals in Multan, before the training. Concluding the meeting Secretary Health South Punjab, Mr Ajmal appreciated WHO Pakistan for its continued support for strengthening the health system in the country and capacity building for COVID-19 Pandemic response.
