## Meeting and Coordination



On 14 June 2021, World Health Organization, Pakistan in collaboration with the Balochistan Institute of Psychiatry and Behavioural Sciences (BIPBS), Quetta organized a consultative meeting to map out referral pathways for Sexual and Gender Based Violence (SGBV) and link them to telemedicine given the current context of COVID-19. The action points from the meeting is expected to strengthen lifesaving health care, psychosocial support, and referral services. The WHO/ NPO SDG provided technical facilitation to the meeting. Participants included representatives from the justice, law, and order sectors of government; UNWOMEN, UNFPA, UNHCR, BRSP, PPHI, WESS and DANESH. During the opening session, The Executive Director BIPBS, Dr Hazrat Ali appreciated WHO Pakistan for the organization and technical facilitation of the innovation that is expected to ease access to services by survivors of SGBV.
