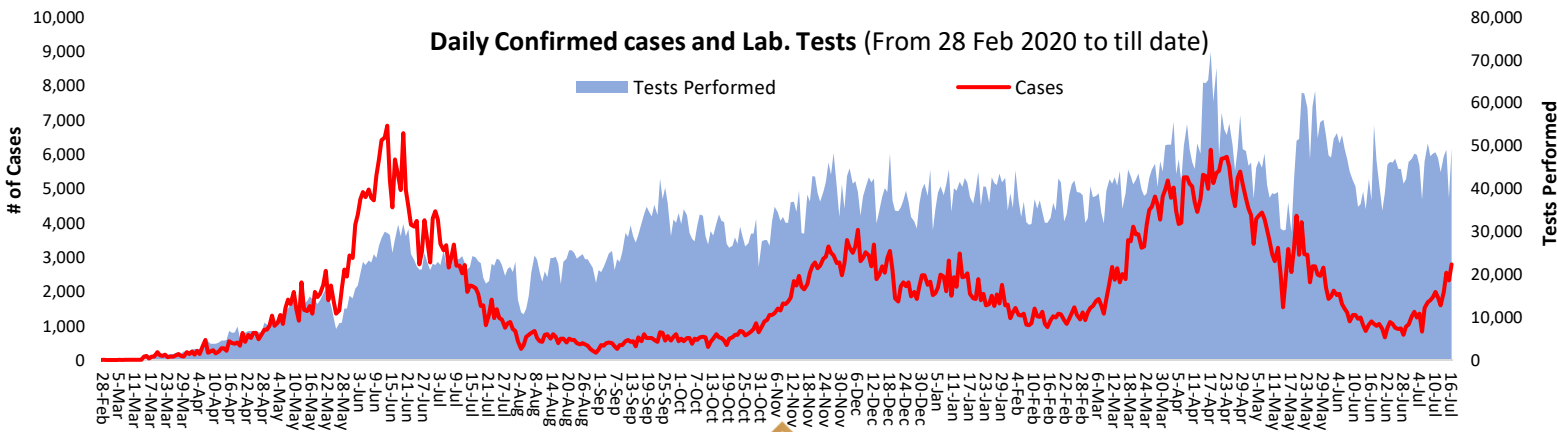

Meeting and Coordination

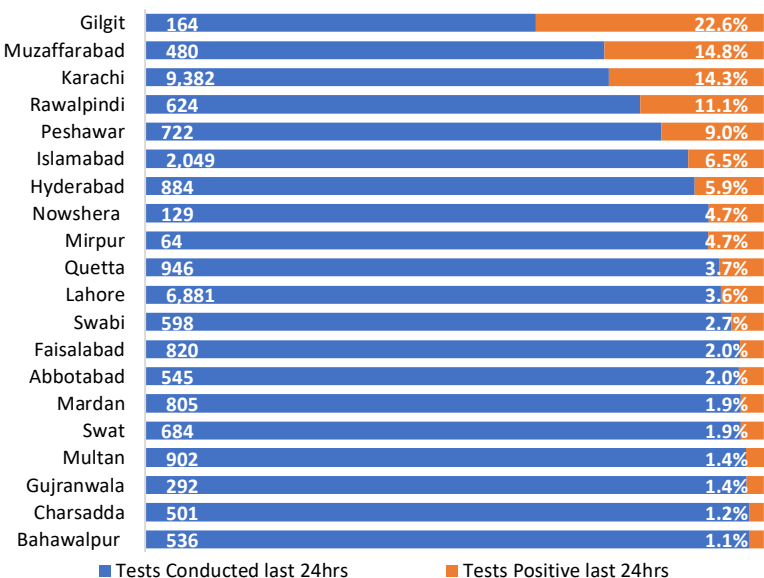


On 12th July 2021, WHO Country Representative, Pakistan Dr Palitha Mahipala convened the 2nd Global Fund Country Coordinating Mechanism (CCM) Quarterly Oversight Committee (OC) meeting at the WHO Country Office Islamabad in his capacity as Chairperson. The objective of the meeting was to review quarterly progress made by the TB Principal recipients; National TB Program (NTP) & Mercy Corps and, plan for election of OC Chair for the next tenure.

The meeting was attended by Vice Chancellor Health services Academy, Dr Shahzad Ali Khan; CCM Coordinator, Hafiz Hammad; representatives of TB Principal Recipients and other CCM OC members USAID, FCDO, UN AIDS, and Association of People living with HIV (APLHIV). In his speech, Dr Palitha reiterated WHO commitment to support CCM in its endeavours to end epidemics of AIDS, Tuberculosis & Malaria. CCM OC members appreciated the leadership of the WHO Pakistan WR in executing the role of chairperson CCM.
