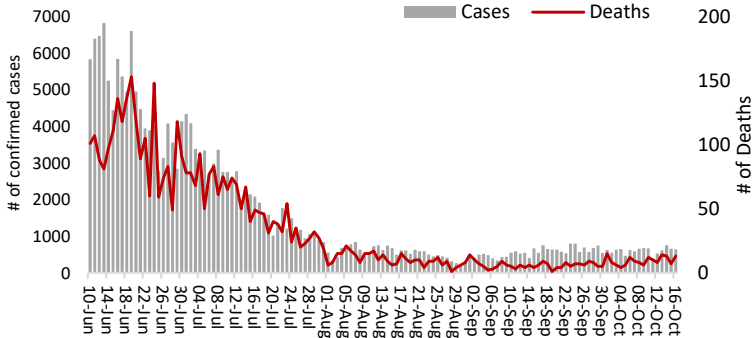

### Executive Summary

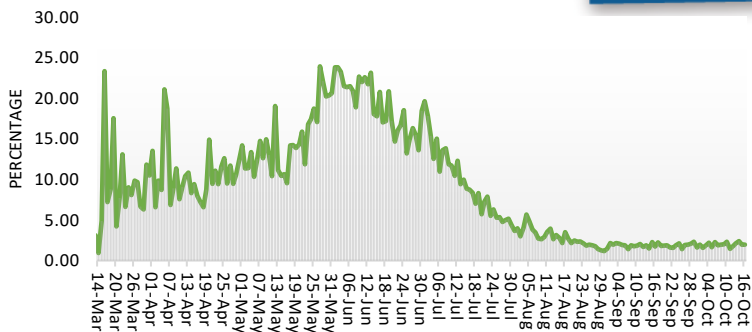
Pakistan reported **641** new cases of COVID-19 on **16 October 2020**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **322,452** with **6,638** deaths (**CFR: 2.06%**). Out of the total **9,174** currently active cases, **833** cases are hospitalized, out of which **567 (68.07%)** are in critical condition. **8,341** COVID-19 positive cases are at designated isolation facilities or in-home isolation. A total of **306,640 (95.10%)** have recovered and discharged.

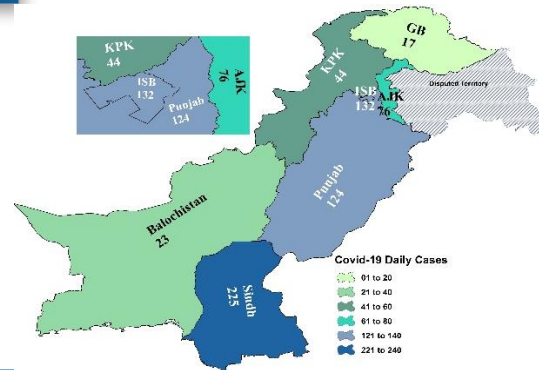

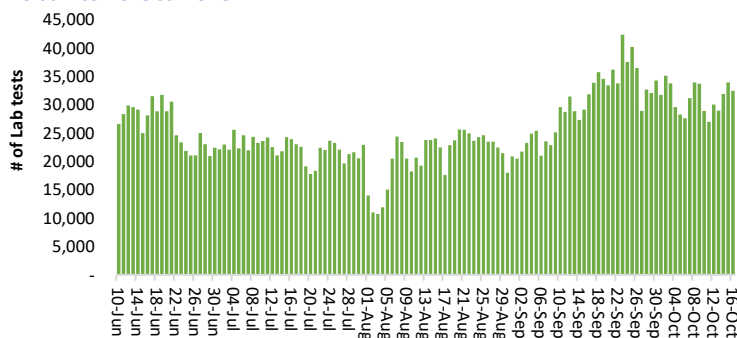

### Daily Incidence by Province



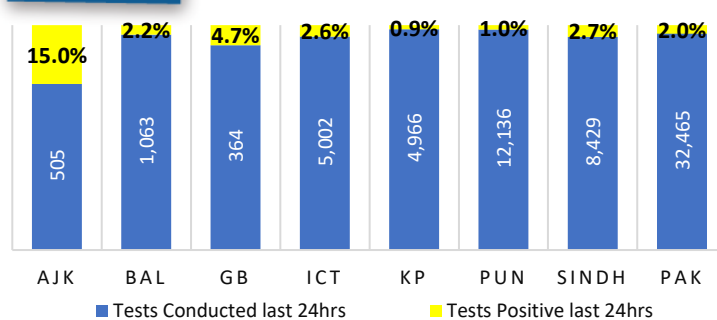

## Meetings & Coordination

A joint mission of WHO Country Office Pakistan and Ministry of National Health Services Regulation and Coordination (NHSR&C) visited Quetta, Balochistan from 15-16 October 2020, to assess the Children Hospital Quetta for upgradation of a Nutrition Stabilisation Centre and establishment of Nutrition Training Center.

The mission also visited the Sandeman Provincial Hospital at the request of the Provincial Nutrition Directorate as a potential site to establish a Nutrition Stabilization Center.

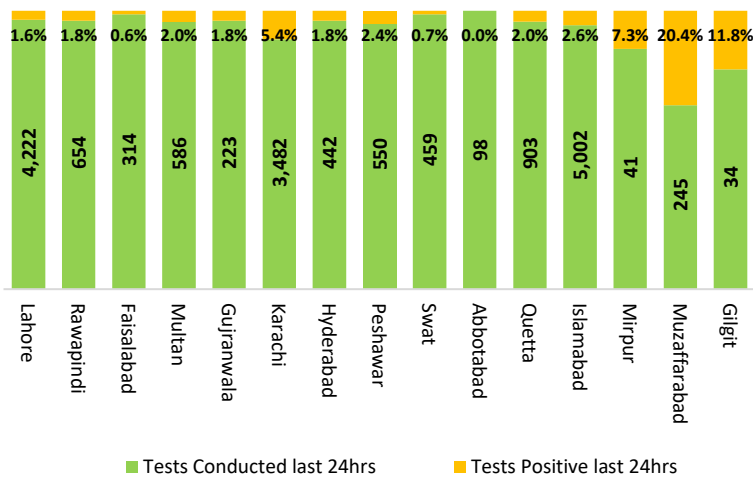
